Boys Track Records: The boys track team had one of the best seasons ever. They took first place in the Piketon Invitational with 126 points and tied with Wheelersburg for top honors in the second annual Notre Dame Invitational with 66 points. The Titan sprint medley team, consisting of Jeff Vetter, Tom Bailey, Chris Henson, and Craig Cameron set a new meet record with a time of 1:43.4. Notre Dame capped another first in the New Boston Invitational with 141 points. Westy Adams and Mark Phillips set new records in the shot put and high hurdles. Notre Dame also won the SOC meet with 124 points. In the Sectional meet the Titans captured first with 74 points. New school records set are: 440 yd dash-Craig Cameron, 52.8; 180 high hurdles-Mark Phillips, 15.8; 220 low hurdles-Dave Byrd and Mark Phillips, 21.9; discus-Bill Debo, 144'0"; shot put-Westy Adams, 52"/2"; mile relay-Henson, Vetter, Ashley, Cameron, 3:34.4. Titans came in third in the Bellaire track meet, qualifying several boys to go to the State meet in Columbus. These included Bill Debo, Westy Adams, Jeff. Vetter, Chris Henson, Jim Ashley, and Craig Cameron. Westy Adams won the Class A shot put in the State with a toss of 52'4".

Girls Track Records: The girls completed an undefeated season and set several new school records. Records broken: 80 yard hurdles, Nancy Porginski- 13.2; 880 medley, Jeanne Pierron, Karen Reinhardt, Lori Miller, Alice Pierron- 1:51.1; 100 yard dash, Nicki Reinhardt- 11.9; mile run- Mary Gemperline- 5:47.5; mile relay, Regina Vetter, Mary Doerr, Genevieve Switalski, Tina Bowman- 4:44; high jump, Gina Bendinelli- 4'11"; long jump, Karen Porginski- 15'21/2"; discus, Jane Herrmann- 111'9". Notre Dame girls also broke three SOC records to become 1976 champions with a final score of 128 points. Jane Herrmann broke the SOC discus record with a throw of 104'61/2"; Mary Gemperline broke the SOC mile run record with a time of 5.59; Karen Reinhardt, Alice Pierron, Nancy Porginski, Nicki Reinhardt, set a new SOC record for the 880 relay with a time of 1:55.7. The Titans took second place in the District meet qualifying several girls for the State meet in Columbus. Included were Gina Bendinelli, Jane Herrmann, Mary Gemperline, Karen Reinhardt, Alice Pierron, Nancy Porginski, Nicki Reinhardt, Jane Herrmann placed 4th in the state for discus and Mary Gemperline placed 10th for the mile run.












