


#### LIBRARY






#### West Journalists

### **CHORUS**






#### **Science Fair**















### **FRESHMEN FOOTBALL**








### GIRLS BASKETBALL





The highlight of the evening was the crowning of this years' prom king and queen, Brian Hopper and Shawnna Bishop.



















































The Senior Who's Who is used to honor seniors who, by attitude and performance, have demonstrated a high degree of academic, artistic, and ethical excellence.
