People are like snowflakes, no two are exactly alike. Each one is unique, playing a vital part in making the world go round.

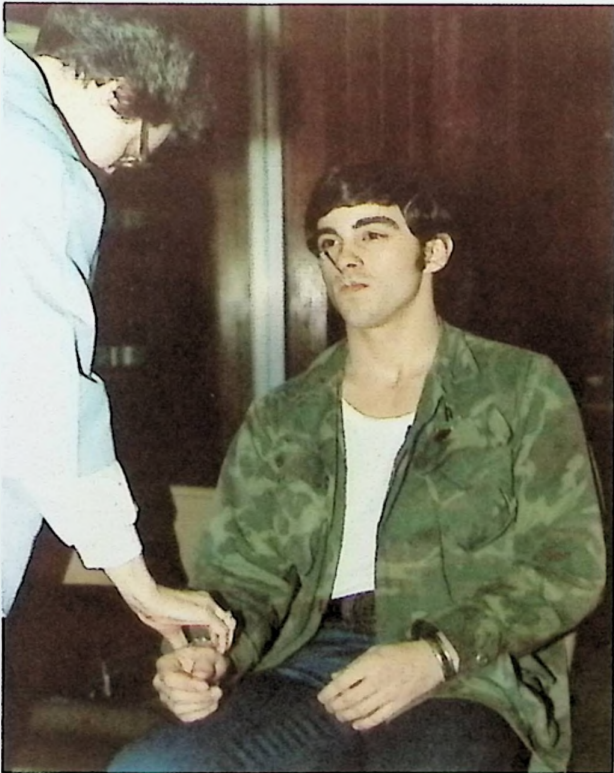
All people feel anger, joy, happiness, boredom, sadness, and love; but how they express these feelings is what makes them unique and different.



People are always competing. Whether it is a basketball game, a baseball game, volleyball or bowling, they play it with the same enthusiasm as they do the most important game of all — the game of life.











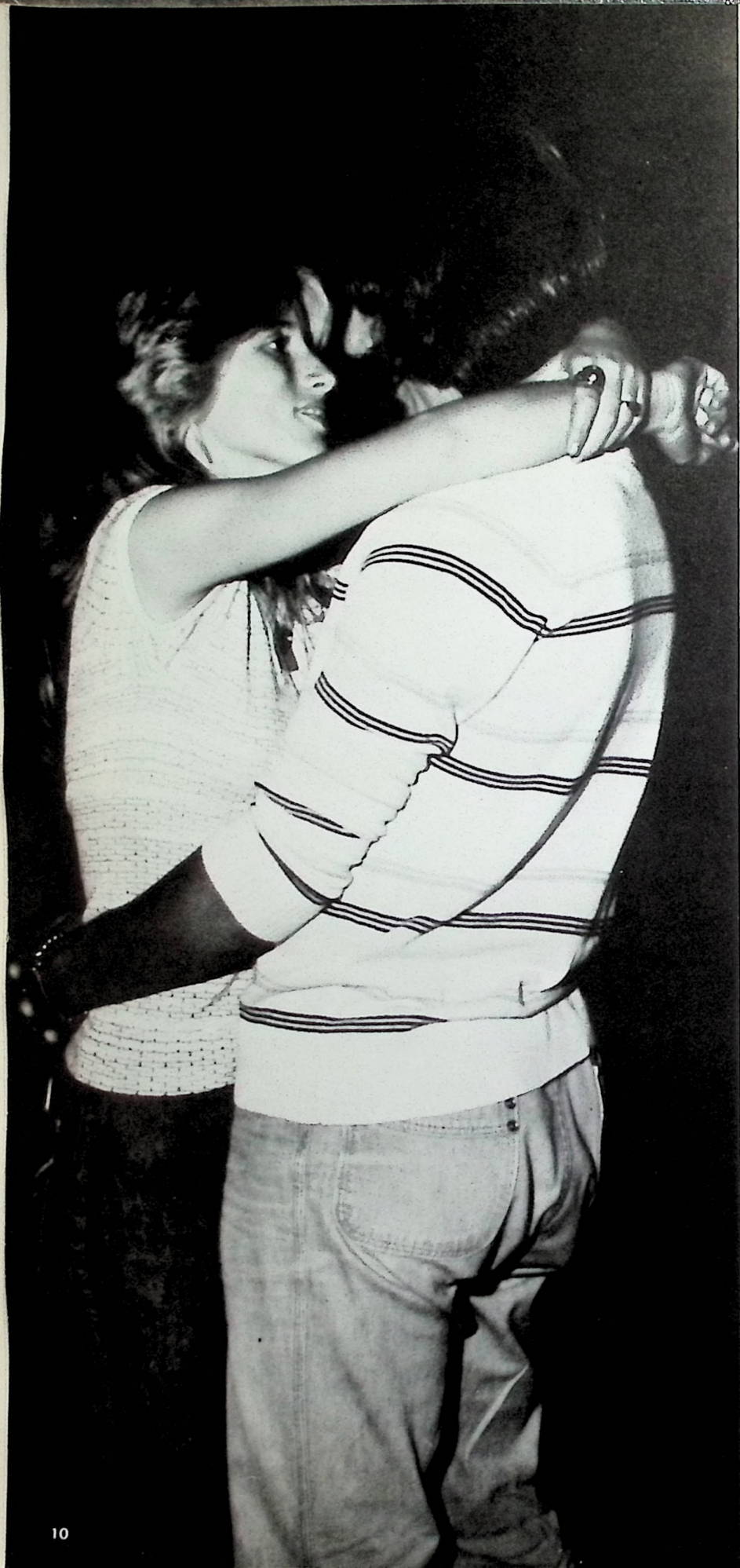

# RIVER DAYS FESTIVAL

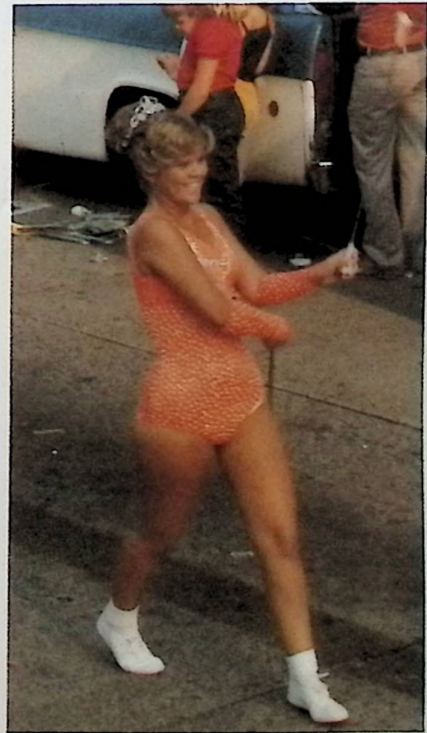

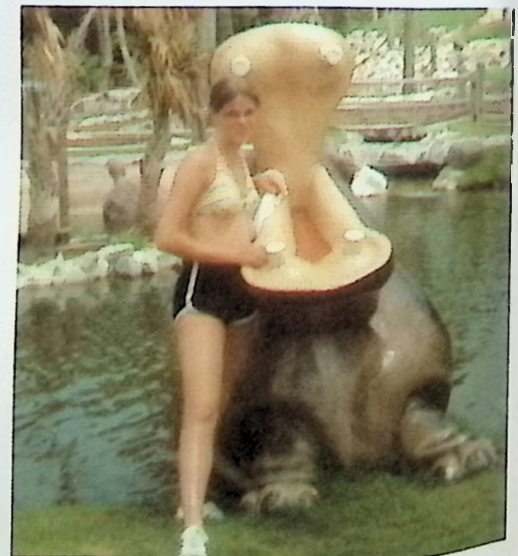


## Fun in the Sun

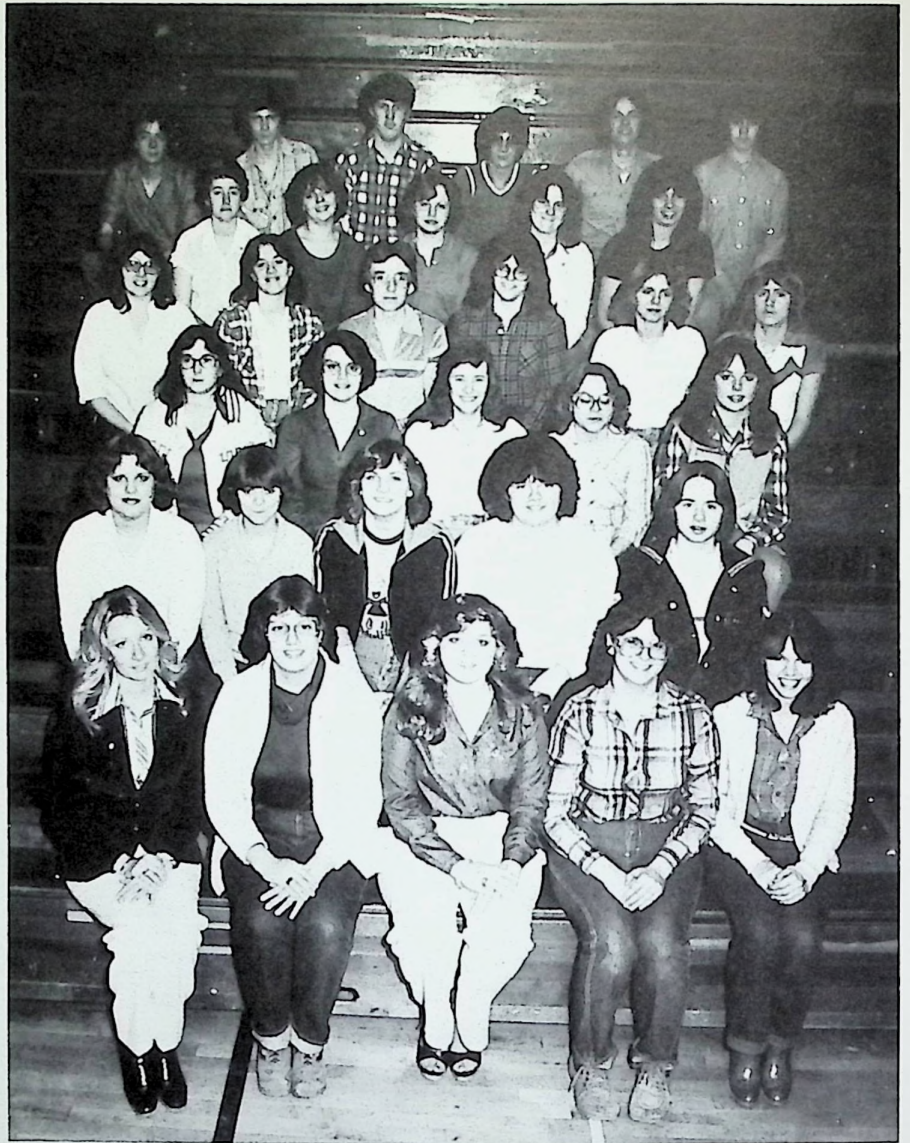
# West Journalists

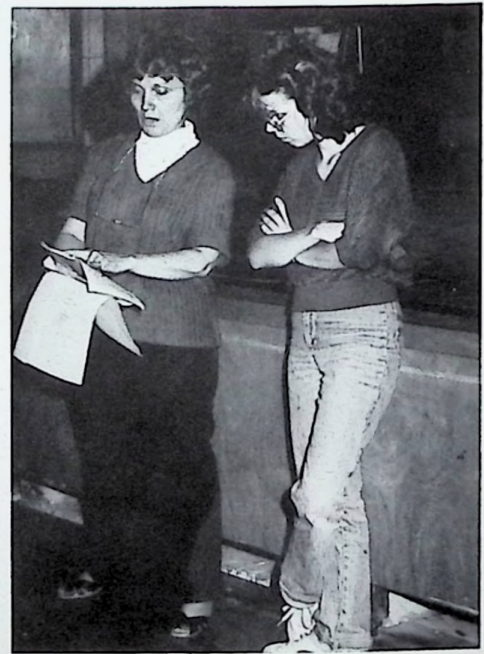


## OFF THE TRACK

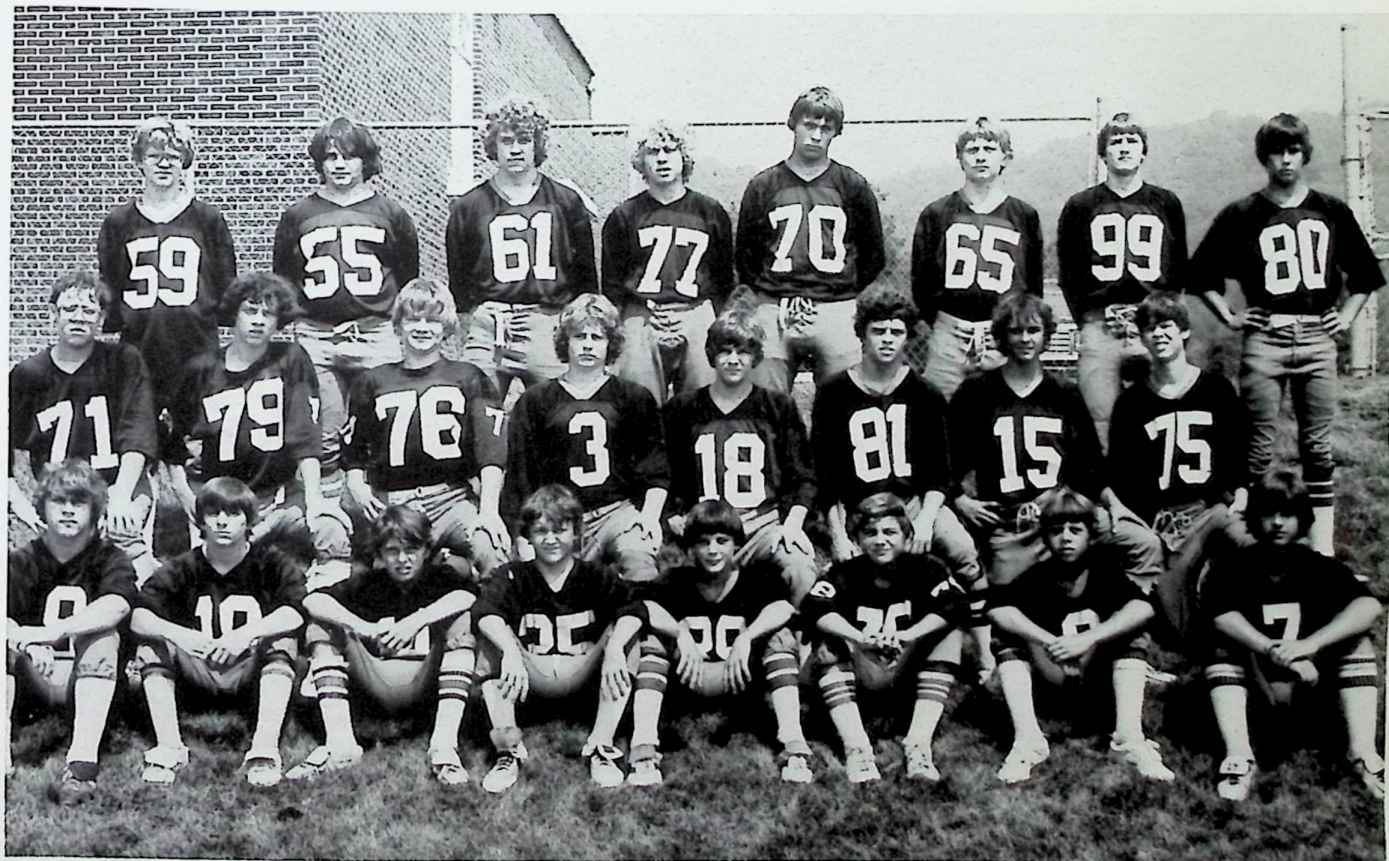






# FRESHMEN FOOTBALL

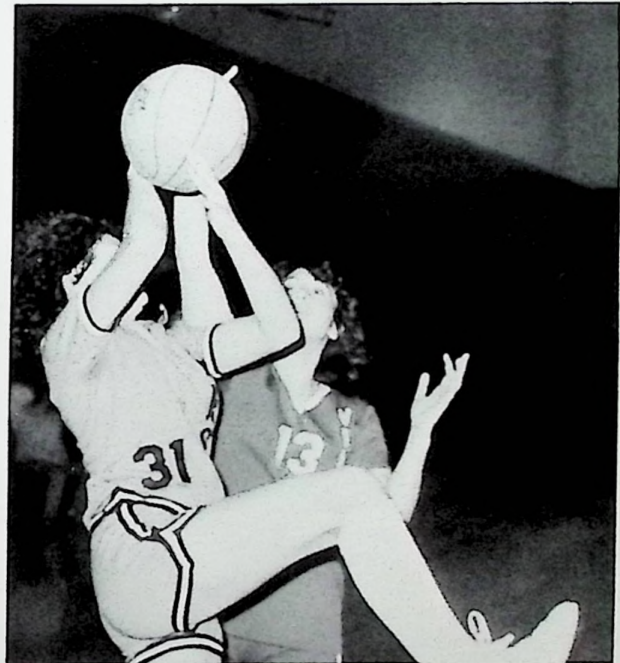
# GIRLS BASKETBALL

The highlight of the evening was the crowning of this years' prom king and queen, Brian Hopper and Shawna Bishop.





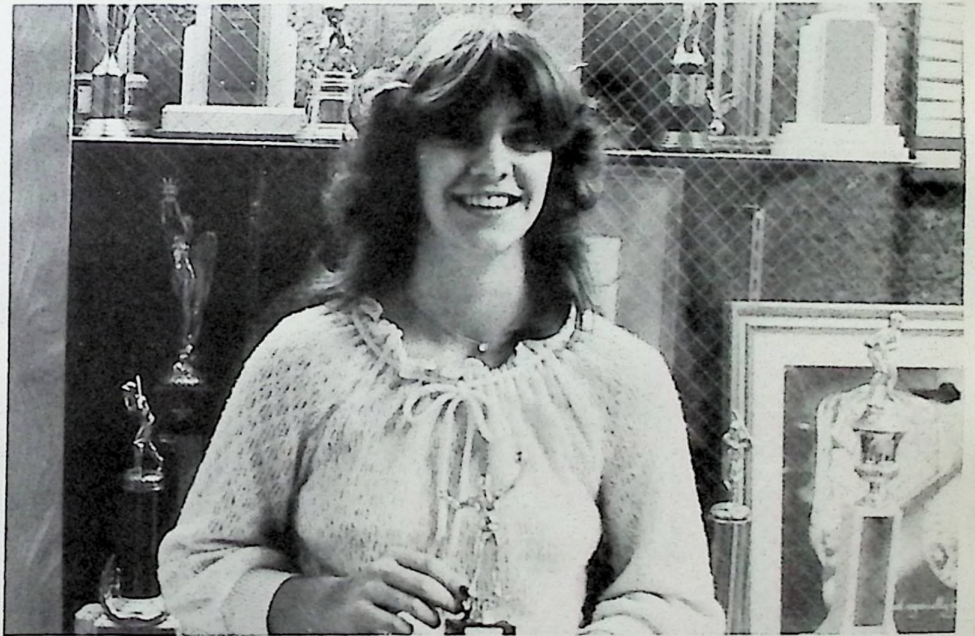








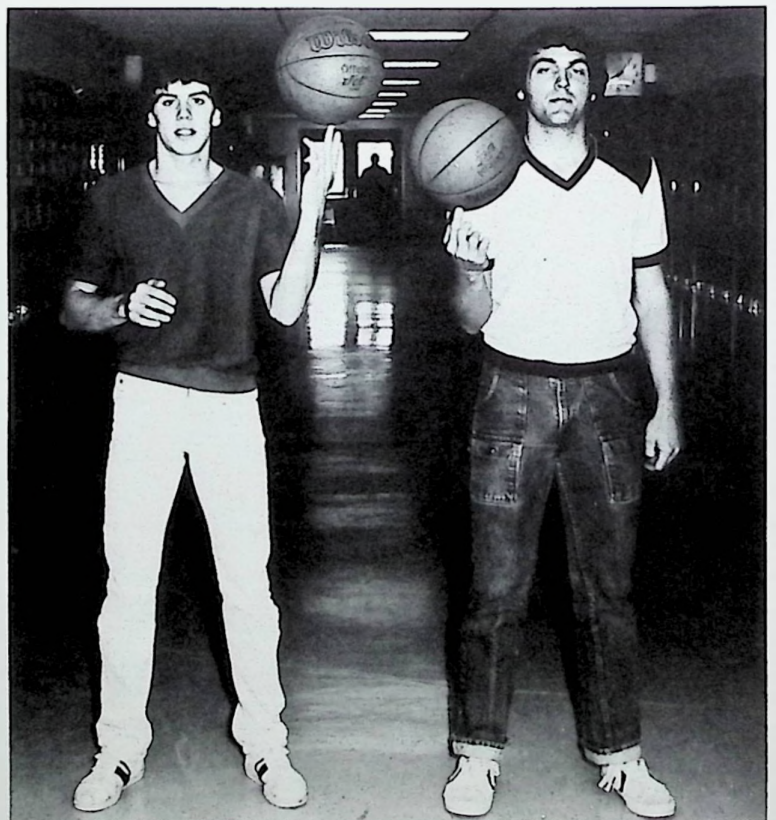
