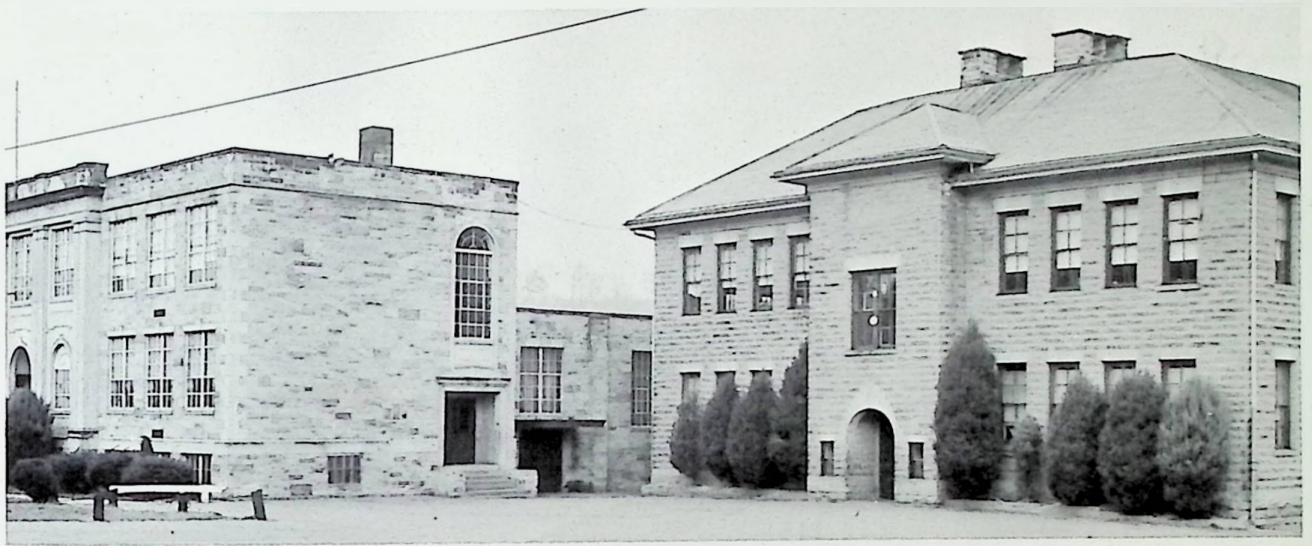
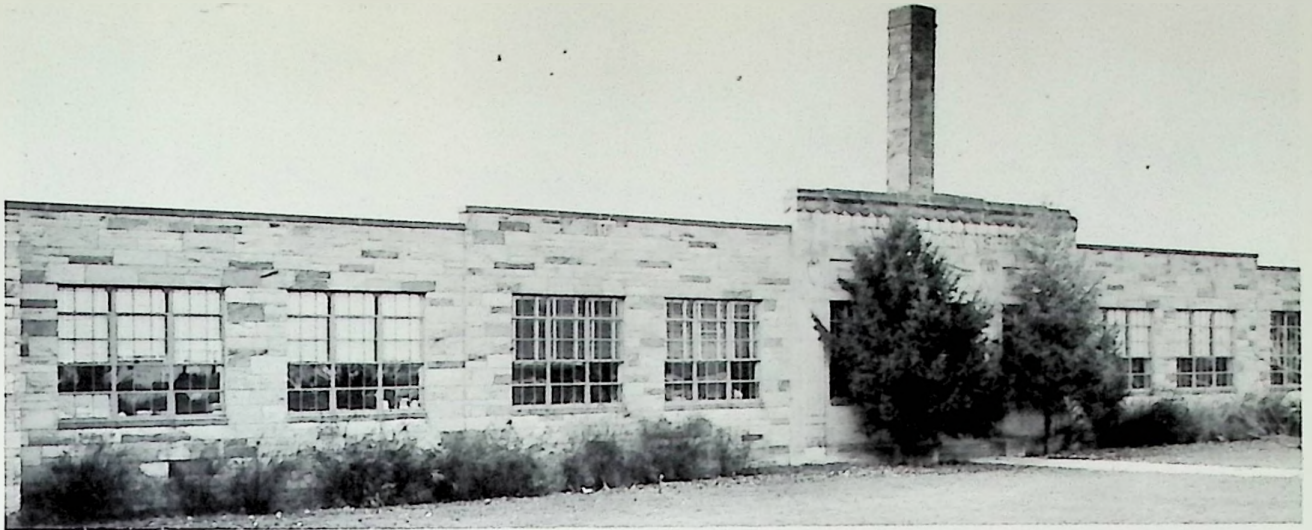






*Community Life*

Along with the old reminders come new business and religious facilities. The pictures represent only a few of the many things that have made our communities what they are today.



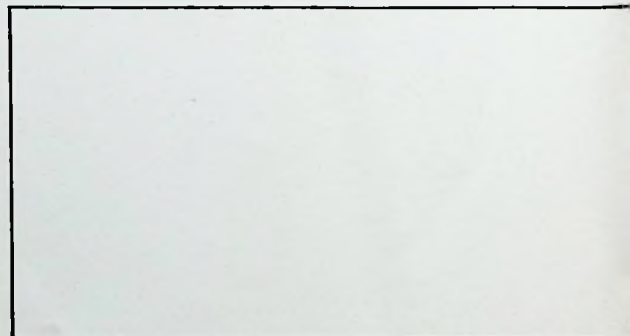
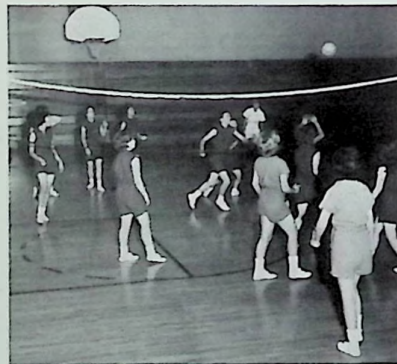
We, the Northwest Annual Staff of 1966, would like to dedicate these two pages of the annual to Mr. Skeens, our advisor for the first semester.

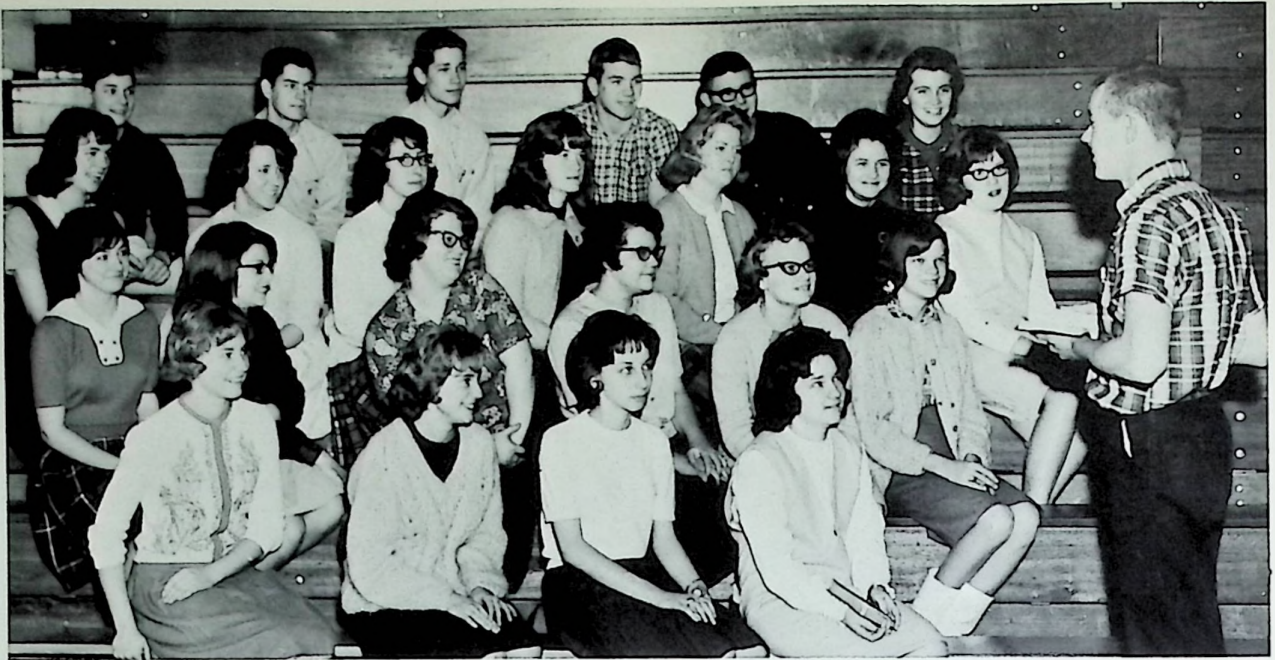
The present and future difficult problems with which we are and will be confronted will take great ability, wisdom, foresight, determination, and fortitude if we are to accomplish what must be accomplished.
