








### Community Life

We shall always remember him as a man who was well equipped for his position, a man of sterling integrity who influenced his students and made them better individuals for his association with them.
















EDUCATION

I want to take this opportunity to congratulate the seniors who are about ready to take their place in our great democratic society. Through hard work, and above all, faith in God, all things can be accomplished."


