September 9, 1977

September 23, 1977

P.H.S. at Boyd County

Trojans Slip In Season Opener

The Trojans drew first blood but Cincinnati LaSalle produced the most points in a hard-earned contest Friday night.

The Lancers unveiled an exciting offense in the first half, and rallied to build a 21-6 lead at the half. Both teams played sound defense, allowing only one touchdown each in the second half. P.H.S. failed to catch the Lancers, and a packed Spartan Stadium saw the Trojans fall 28-14.

Tom Boden had the first Trojan score on a 57 year burst and Jim Murray came through on a 78 yard pass play from Boden to add some excitement for the Trojans.

September 16, 1977

P.H.S. at Ironton

Lions Claw Trojans

The Portsmouth Trojans came away empty handed as the Boyd County Lions slipped by with a three point victory at the winners' home field.

In the first two quarters, both teams exchanged punts several times. The Trojans scored in the second quarter with only two minutes left.

The second half got rolling when Kreg Jones picked off a Boyd County pass. Portsmouth rambled down field, deep into Lion territory as Senior back Steve Parker broke the ice with a 13 yard burst in the end zone.

Both teams scored two touchdowns each. The difference in the score, however, caused by the Trojans' inability to make their extra points. P.H.S. dropped to 0-3 in the season, losing by a score of 15-12.

The Trojans unsung heroes were Jim Murray, who caught a 80 yard touchdown pass from quarterback Tom Boden with about five minutes left in the game, and Tony Moore, who gained 34 yards on 8 carries in his first starting assignment.

Tigers Tame Trojans

The Portsmouth Trojans lost their second game in a row in the hands of the Ironton Fighting Tigers Friday night.

The first half saw both teams display a good defense, until P.H.S. broke the ice in the second quarter, with senior Tom Grashel intercepting a pass to set up the Trojans only score of the game. Ironton was then forced to rally late in the second quarter to tie it up 8-8 at the end of the half.

The Trojans came out fired up in the third period but made costly turnovers and errors which led to a 20-8 win for Ironton. Jim Murray scored the lone Portsmouth touchdown on a 53 yard pass from Tom Boden. Jeff Lisath caught a 3 yard pass for the conversion.

September 30, 1977

Greenup County at P.H.S.

Musketeers Get First Win Against Trojans

The Musketeers beat the Trojans for the first time in the five years of rivalry between the two teams. This game put the Trojans at 0-4 for the

season and 0-2 In the Tri-State Athletic Conference.

Greenup scored twice in the first quarter, making the second touchdown with just 51 seconds left. After the kickoff, Portsmouth ran thirteen plays, getting two first downs, but were stopped on the two-yard line. After another Greenup touchdown, the score stood at 20-0 at the half.

In the second half of the game, the Trojans picked up a Greenup fumble and went 25 yards in two plays for the lone Trojan score. The final score was 35-6.

Steve Parker led the Trojan offense with 99 yards on 18 carries. Jeff Lisath was the star receiver with five receptions while Scott Burrows led the Trojan defense in tackles.

October 7, 1977

P.H.S At Huntington East

Highlanders Outmuscle Trojans

The P.H.S. Trojans came away on the tail end of a 26-14 defeat as they lost their fifth straight game with a win Friday night to the Huntington East Highlanders.

The Trojan men battled all through the first half but could not gain any ground as the Highlanders built up a sound 19-0 lead when the gun went

off ending the first half of play.

Early in the third frame Huntington East scored quickly and lead 26-0 and it seemed like the game was out of reach. Still the stubborn Trojans failed to give up as Junior Scott Burrows carried the football over the goal line for the first Trojan score. Tom Boden helped out the Trojan cause by zeroing in on Jim Murray who trucked 29 yards for the second P.H.S. score of the half. As the time ran out, the Trojans went down with dignity thanks too the efforts of Kirk McMahon and Tom Grashel who contributed great defensive play throughout the game.

October 14, 1977

Huntington at P.H.S.

Trojans Are Triumphant At Homecoming

The P.H.S. Trojans captured their First victory of the 1977 Season with a 32-14 win mopping over the Huntington Pony Express.

Tom Boden opened the scoring with an exciting 83 yard punt return to end zone that was the longest of the year for the team. This dance, which was formerly under the supervision of the Art Department, is sponsored this year by the Senior Class. Kreg Jones, president, made the request.


