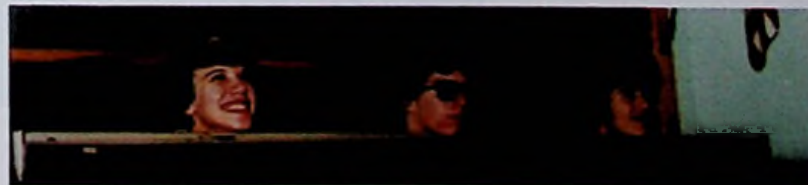

We measure the passage of time in months and years. The seventies are ending; we are anticipating the eighties. As the decade is coming to a close, we take a nostalgic look at 1979.





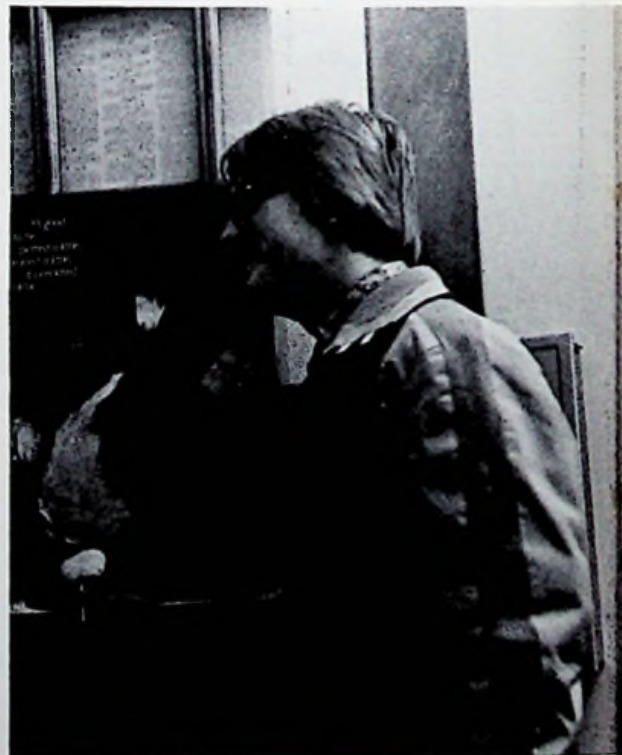


Some people never stop posing:

to get the rules straight.



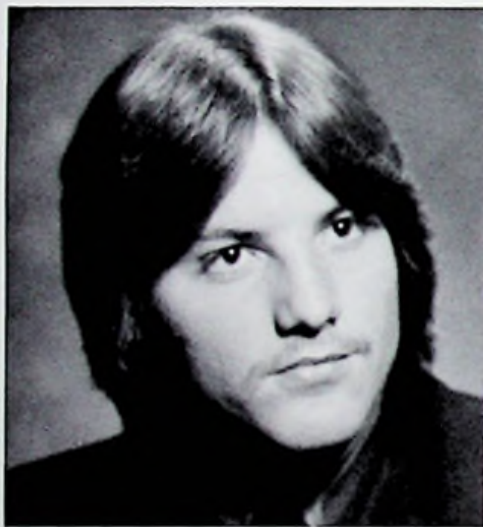
