



Men Of Troy Are Awesome

The Trojan football team opened the season with a 40 to 20 win over Chillicothe. A high point of the season was when the Trojans defeated the Ironton Tigers 19 to 10. stopping a Tiger 64 game winning streak. After winning five of the next six games, the Trojans were victorious over the Portsmouth West Senators. By defeating the Senators, the Trojans became the No. I team in their computer region. This win enabled the 6th ranked Trojans to play the first football playoff game in the school's history on its home field. The Trojans conquered the Philo Electrics, 14-13 in the first round of the Division III football playoffs. After the victory over Philo, the Trojans played the Cincinnati McNicholas Rockets at Middletown in the semi-final round of the football playoffs. Even though they lost to the Rockets, the Trojans had an outstanding season, and are looking forward to next year.


