Representing us in the Tartan King and Queen contest were Anita Collins and Bub Simpson, while Paula Holland was selected as our Homecoming attendant. Kevin Christopher, Dennis Weaver, and Joe Van Dyke were district winners on the scholarship tests.

Gaining confidence after a hectic freshman year, our sophomore class was led by Jeff Hood, president; Penny Jordan, vice-president; Jami Spriggs, treasurer; and Connie Buchanan, secretary. Peppy girls in our class were: Nancy Sapp and Linda Holbrook, majorettes; Mary Bayerl, Paula Holland, Penny Jordan, and Vicki Williams, reserve cheerleaders. Kevin Christopher and Dennis Weaver placed in the state on the scholarship tests while Jeff Hood, Janie Sergent, and Joe Van Dyke were district winners. The Rotary Club sponsored Jeff Hood as a delegate to the Junior Science and Humanities Symposium. Our sophomore class selected Penny Jordan as our Homecoming attendant and Connie Buchanan and Rod Chamberlain as Tartan King and Queen candidates. Selected as Prom waiters and waitresses were the following: Rod Chamberlain, Jim Roney, Joe Van Dyke, Lowell Welch, Leita Bussey, Connie Buchanan, Linda Holbrook, and Paula Holland.

The big event of our junior year was the Prom with the theme "The Age of Aquarius." Our class worked diligently on fund-raising projects such as magazine sales and the varsity basket ball concession stand. Leading our fearless junior class were Jeff Hood, president; Paula Holland, vice-president; Patty Riggs, treasurer; and Connie Buchanan, secretary. Nancy Sapp was our only majorette and Mary Bayerl, Paula Holland, Penny Jordan, and Vicki Williams were our varsity cheerleaders. Patty Riggs was selected as our Homecoming attendant and also our River Days candidate. Nancy Sapp and Bennie Hall represented us in the Tartan King and Queen contest. Inducted into the National Honor Society during our junior year were Jeff Hood, Jeff Mauk, Janie Sergent, Darrell Stapleton, and Joe Van Dyke. Other awards were: Darrell Stapleton, Junior Cup; Jeff Hood, Woodsmen of
the World Award; and Jeff Hood, representative to the Junior Science and Humanities Symposium. Kevin Christopher attended Buckeye Boy's State and Penny Jordan was our delegate to Girl's State. Jeff Hood was a state winner and Al Armbrister and Joe Van Dyke were district winners on the scholarship tests. Achievements in spring sports during our junior year showed Al Armbrister on our golf team, placing third in state competition; Darryl Davis, Bennie Hall, Jim Roney, and Jeff Walburn on the mile relay team, which finished fifth in the state; and Bob McCann, Darrell Stapleton, and Lowell Welch placed third in the state on our baseball team.

Our graduating class of 94 was headed by Jeff Hood, president; Penny Jordan, vice-president; Jeff Mauk, treasurer; and Janie Sergent, secretary. Inducted into the National Honor Society were the following: Al Armbrister, Leita Bussey, Paula Holland, Penny Jordan, Kevin Mershon, Patty Riggs, Jim Roney, Dennis Weaver, and Doretha Wilson. Selected as co-valedictorians were Kevin Christopher, Darrell Stapleton, and Joe Van Dyke, while co-salutatorians were Jeff Hood, Jeff Mauk, and Dennis Weaver Patty Riggs was our Homecoming Queen and Leita Bussey was senior attendant. Jami Spriggs and Jeff Hood were our Tartan King and Queen representatives. Varsity cheerleaders were Mary Bayerl, Paula Holland, and Penny Jordan while Connie Buchanan, Linda Holbrook, and Nancy Sapp were our majorettes. Bob McCann received honorable mention-All Ohio basketball team. Bennie Hall captured 6th place in the 440 yard dash while the mile relay team, consisting of Darryl Davis, Bennie Hall, Jim Roney, and Jeff Walburn, placed 7th in the state track meet. Jami Spriggs received the D.A.R. Award and Joe Van Dyke received the Distinguished Musicians Award. Kevin Christopher and Jeff Hood placed in the state and Janie Sergent placed in the district on the scholarship tests. Joe Van Dyke was selected as an Outstanding Senior by the Kiwanis Club and Darrell Stapleton and Dennis Weaver were Rotary Club delegates. Al Armbrister, Kevin Christopher, Phyllis DeAutremont, Jeff Hood, and Nancy Sapp received State Board Certificates. Darrell Stapleton was given the Sandy Pence Award. We finished our tumultuous four years at East on Tuesday, June 6, 1972 with graduation in the East High auditorium.
