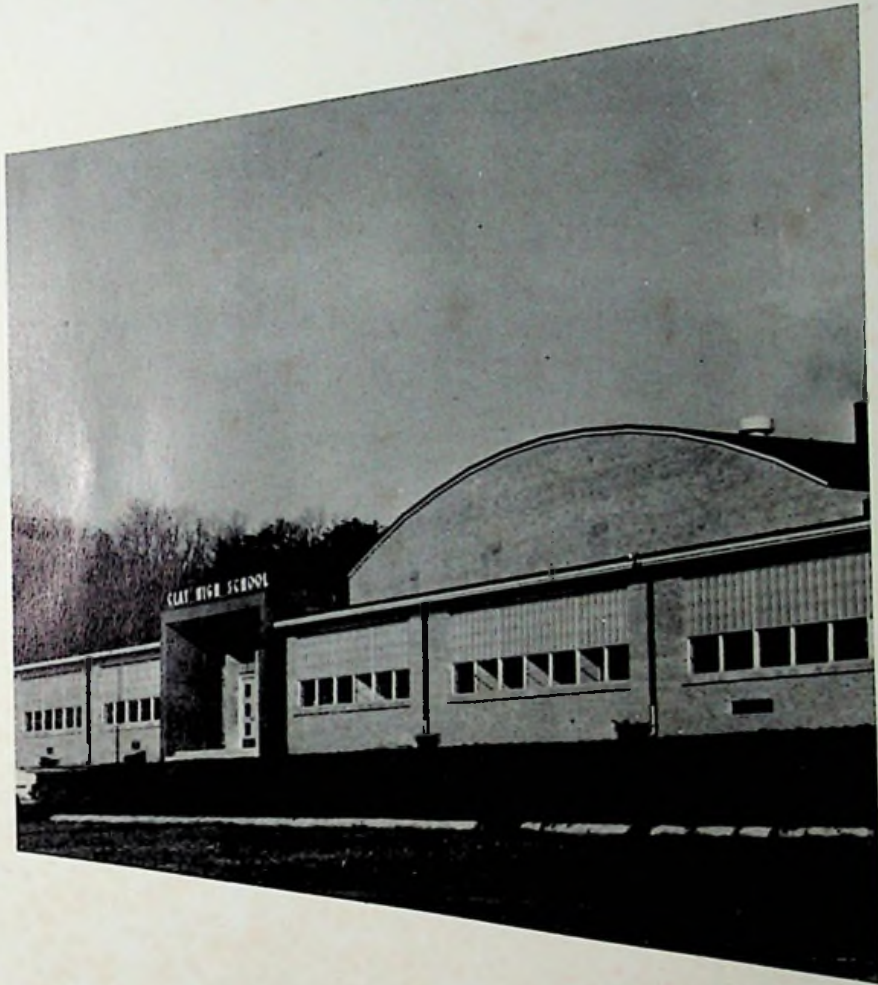

FOREWORD

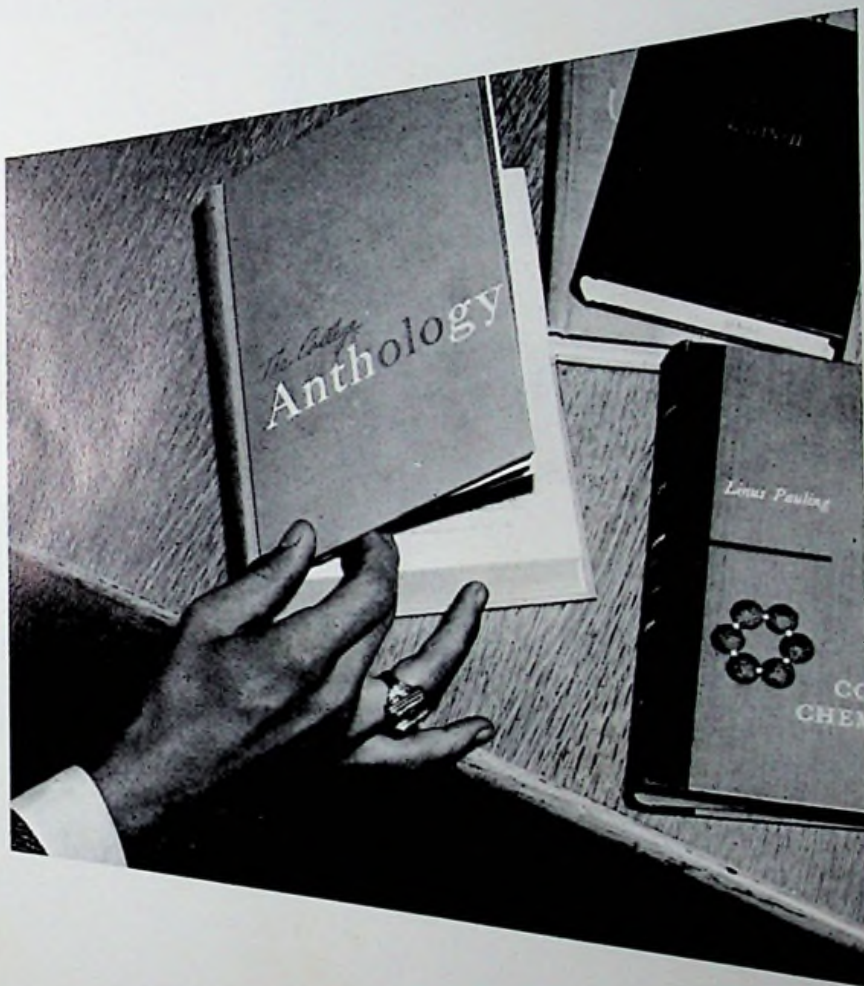

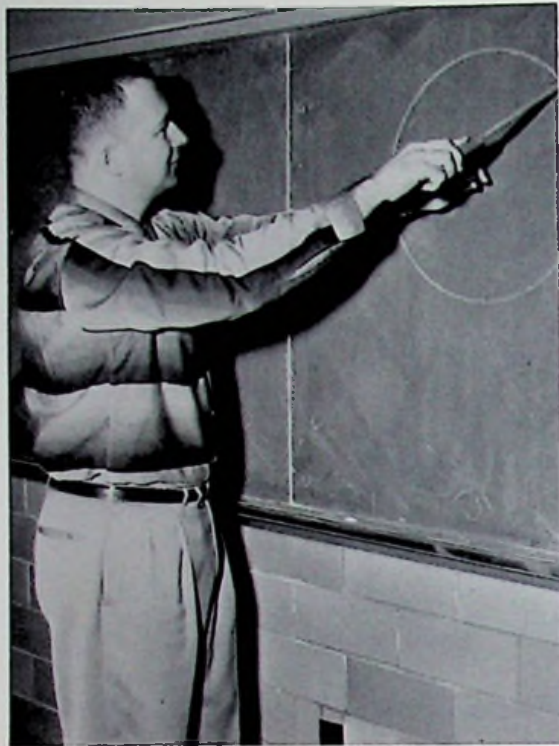

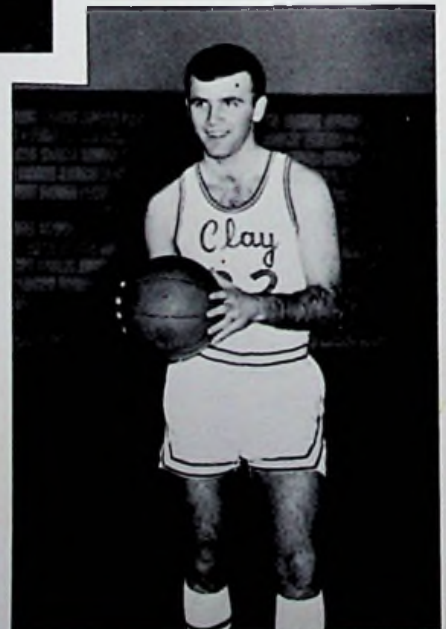

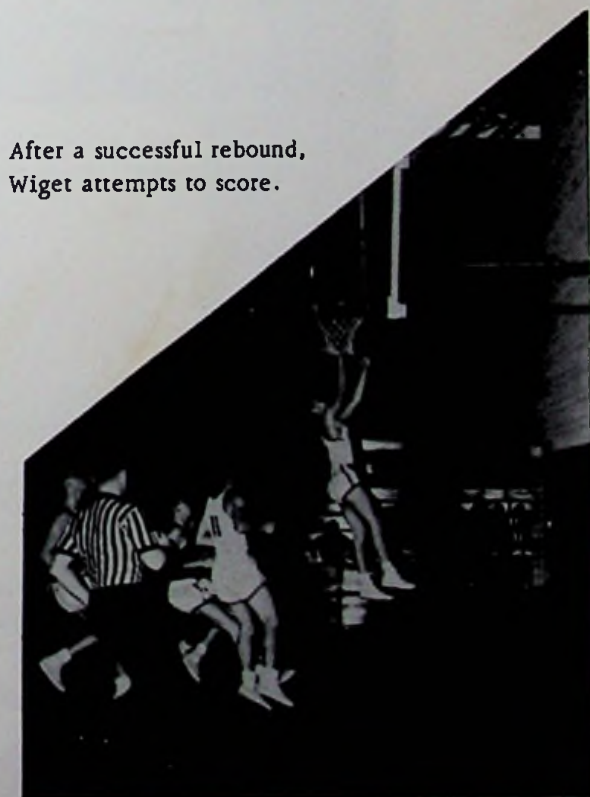
