Rained during the after part of the night and forepart of the day. Showed thin out of the time. We were all at home and alone. Smith and I have bottled the sheep out of the chaffins. I filled a few tins. I have eat several turnips and a good lot of cabbages.

Jan. 12.

Spit snow all day. I went up to our chopper and worked an hour with Squire. He took sick so we came home. I cleaned stable and ground axen the best of the time. Mr. Hobbs came here and eat dinner with us. He reports that the weather dry.

A cold windy day. Snowed and froze a little last night. Spit snow to day. The bunches two hog, this forenoon. After dinner Squire Smith & I chopped wood. I have practiced an hour on the organ this evening.
