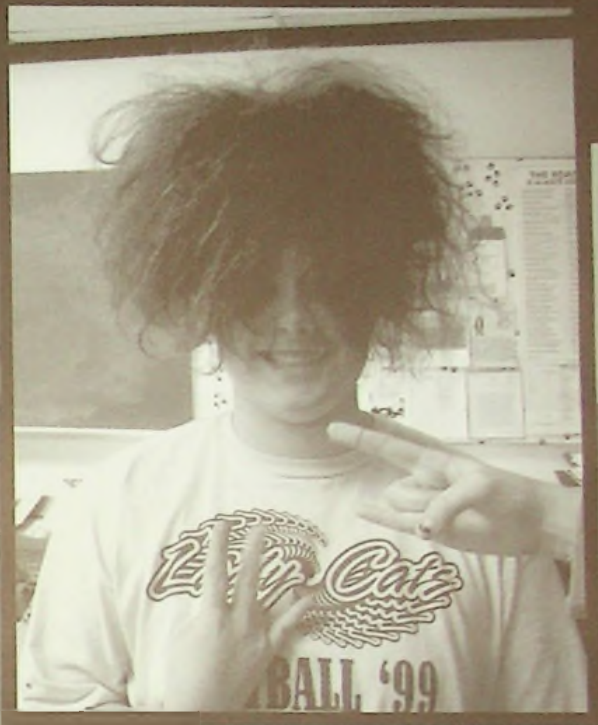


JVS Completion Ceremony
