## Class Fistory of 1970

The all-star cast of 71 enthusiastic performers made their daring debut on September 7, 1966, staged at Glenwood High School. The leading roles were portrayed by Sue Mercer, President; Debbie Moore, VicePresident; SuzyAdkins, Secretary; Ricki Fraley, Treasurer, and Vema Riffe, Reporter. We had a special guest appearance by the glamourous starlet, Brenda Emshwiller as Homecoming attendant. Playing supporting roles were Cheryl McClure and Terry Jones as our Annual nominees. We were managed by Mr. Joe Jenkins and Mrs. Kir Schisler.

Summer stock had ended and on September 1, 1967, we began the second year of our run with a cast of 62. The leads were stolen by upcoming personalities: Debbie Moore, President; Brenda Emshwiller, Vice-President; Annie Thompson, Secretary; Cheryl McClure, Treasurer, and Lana Clifton, Reporter. The celebrity of the year was Jo Ellen McKelvey when we selected her as our Homecoming attendant. Our managers remained the same.

After 3 months vacation from our tedious schedule, we 51 Juniors were ready to begin again. On September. 3, 1968, we advanced from the amateur into the professional realm. Due to the success of our previous years with G. H. S. , we now had added responsibilities. The major characters were assumed by Tom Jones, President; Fred Dodd, Vice-President; Suzy Adkins, Secretary; Don Skaggs, Treasurer; and Vema Riffe, Reporter. We chose as our Homecoming attendant the lovely debutante, Miss Kathy Lodwick. One of the exciting events of the season was purchasing our class rings - the status symbol of our elite group. The highlighting performance was our adaptation of "Girl Crazy" - a three-act comedy which was directed by Mr. David Daum. This was presented on March 14, 1969. To conclude our third season, we honored the Seniors with a fabulous ball, "Three Coins in a Fountain," on May 23, 1969. Looking back on our Junior year we felt we had gained valuable experience and were eagerly anticipating our fourth and final year at G.H.S.

On September 3, 1969, we remaining 48 Seniors retumed to the familiar set of Glenwood. For efficient leadership we chose Fred Dodd, President; Joe Ellen McKelvey, Vice-President; Vema Riffe, Secretary; Don Skaggs, Treasurer; and Debbie Moore, Reporter. We also had a change in management. This year we were to be under Mr. Joe Jenkins and Mr. John Simpson. For the season we put the spotlight on Brenda Emshwiller as "Miss Tiger Touchdown." Terri Roberts shared in the glory as Senior attendant. The command performance for our final season was the presentation of "Our Miss Brooks," directed by Mrs. Cleo P. Rittenhouse on November 20, 1969. After $81 / 2$ months of the same scenery, we decided to change location. For three brief, but glorious days we toured Washington, D. C. under the brilliant guidance of Mr. Jack Pauley. After being reinstated to our previous positions, we were now ready to complete the last leg of our run. To commemerate the close of our career at Glenwood, the Juniors honored us with a prom, very appropriately entitled, "Shower of Stars," on May 22, 1970.

At the close of our four year Grand Performance, we gave our final curtain calls at Baccalaureate, May 24, and Commencement, May 26,1970 . Stealing the show were Suzy Adkins and Vema Riffe as co-Valedictorians, and Debbie Moore as Salutatorian. Looking back, we realize that these past four years have helped prepare us for our future participation upon the stage of life.
