A school's purpose being primarily academic, all honor members must maintain a 3.0 average or above.

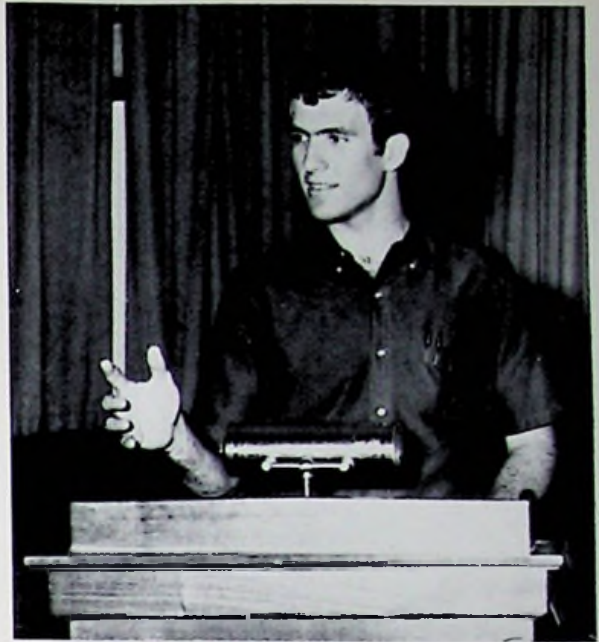
