It was all worth the trouble. I can't wait until next year's prom.






The memory that I treasure the most is when I was in a basketball game. The game was at Portsmouth High School. The guys on the team were really tall and were supposed to be pretty good.






TEEN INSTITUTE

While speaking to the students she reached them and told them that this could also happen to them


