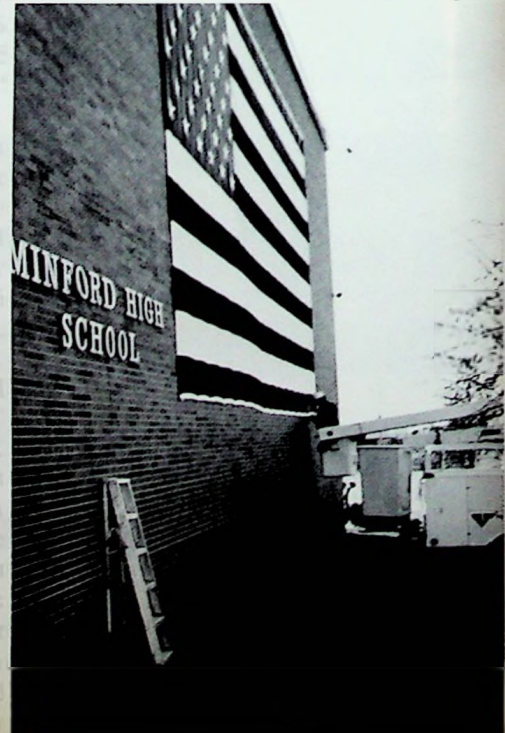


A NEW PATRIOTISM

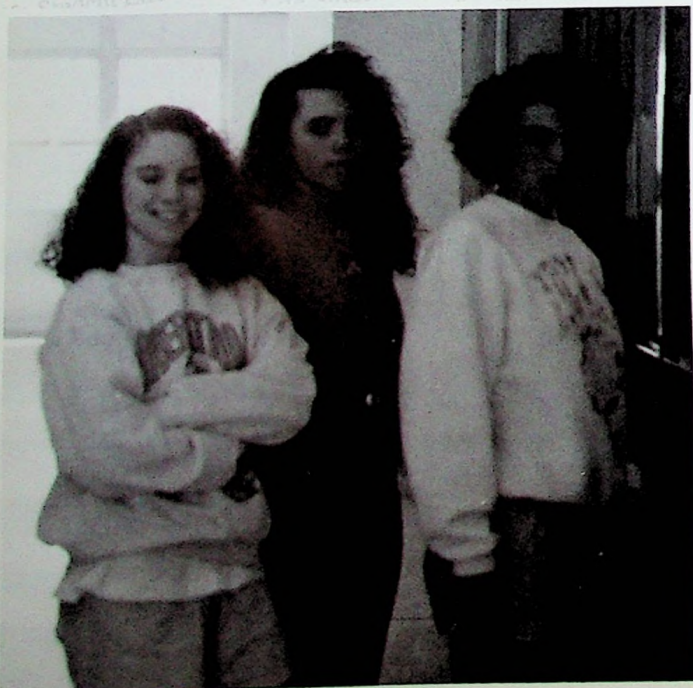

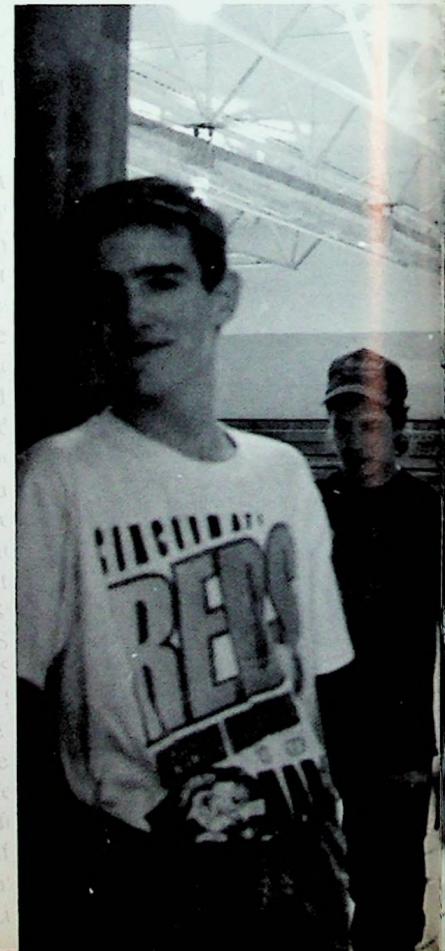
Verne Riffe III presented the school an American Flag on behalf of his father Verne Riffe II, Speaker of the Ohio House of Representatives.



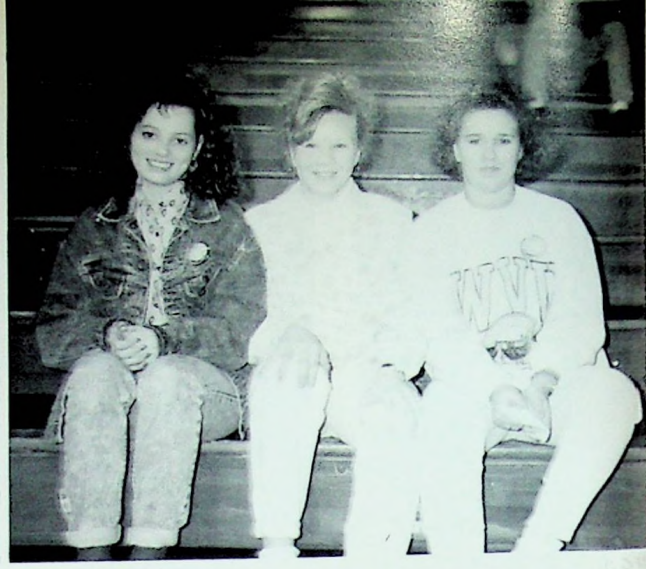

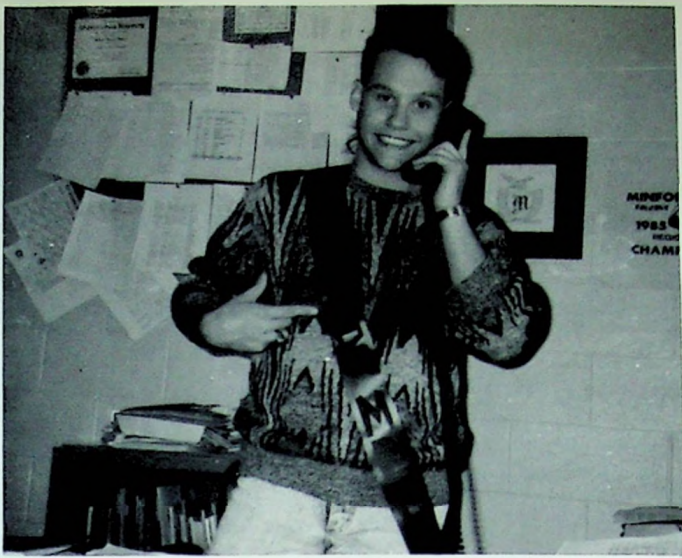

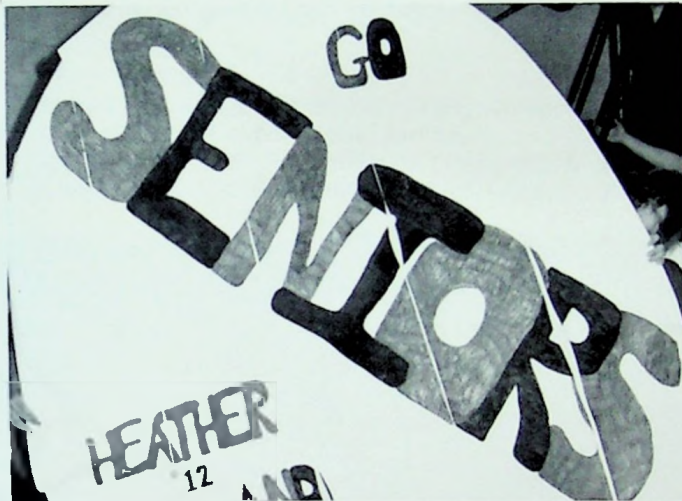

It was all worth the trouble. I can't wait until next year's prom.

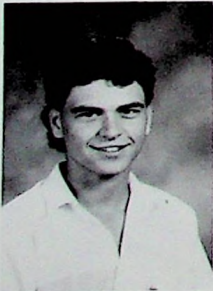

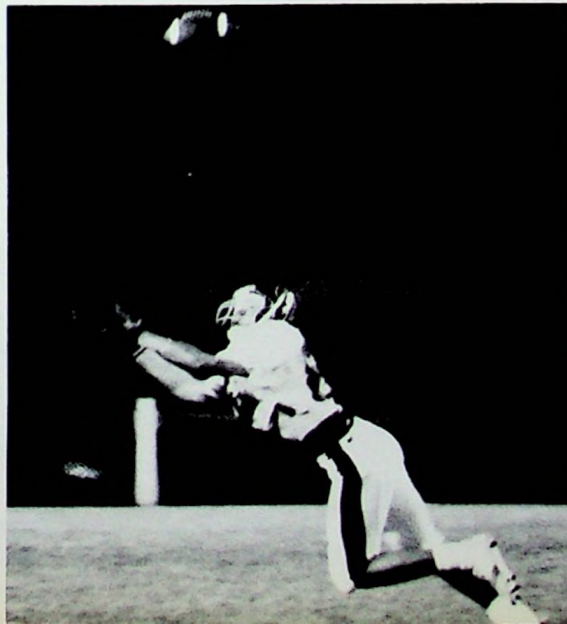

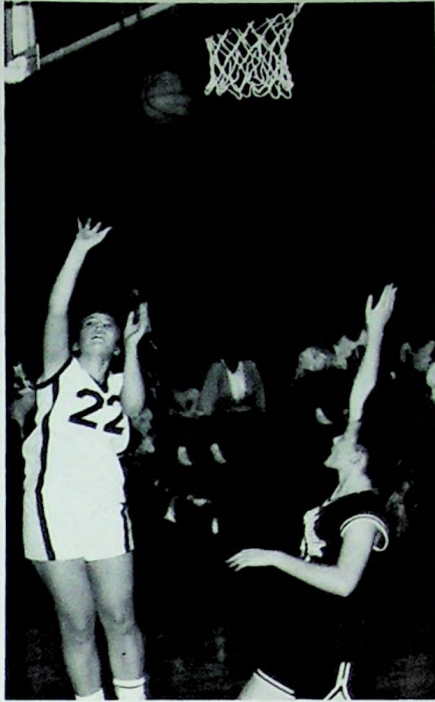
