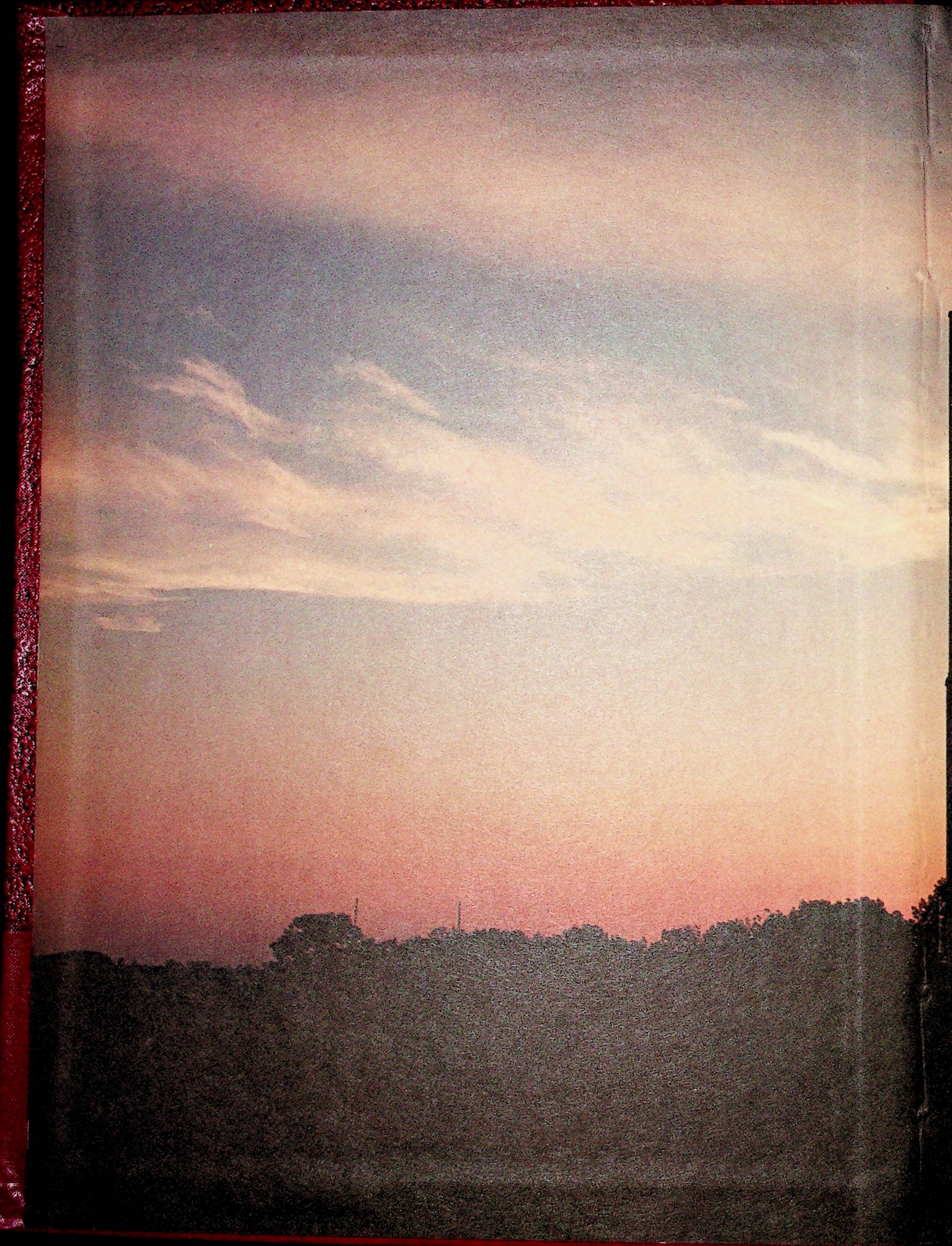
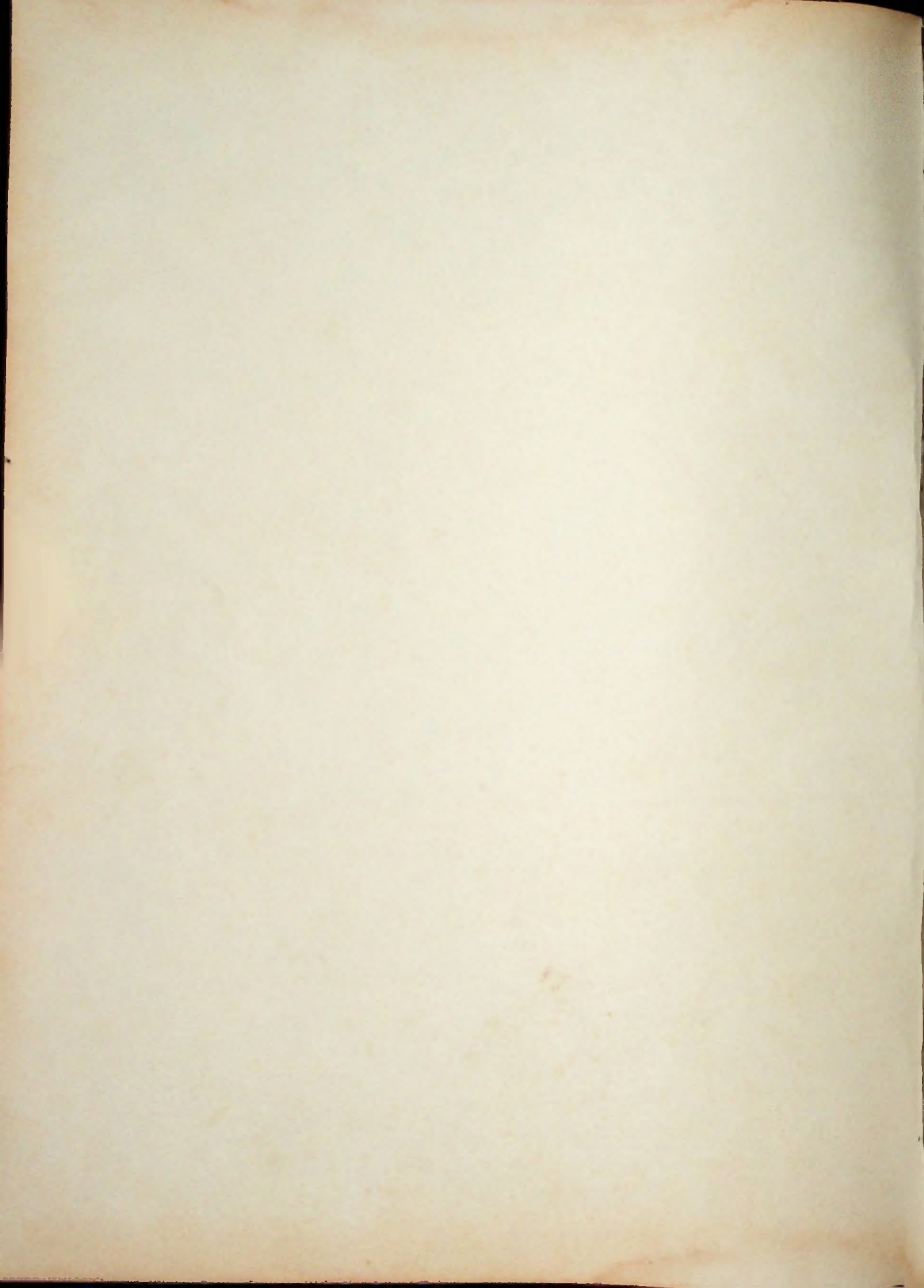

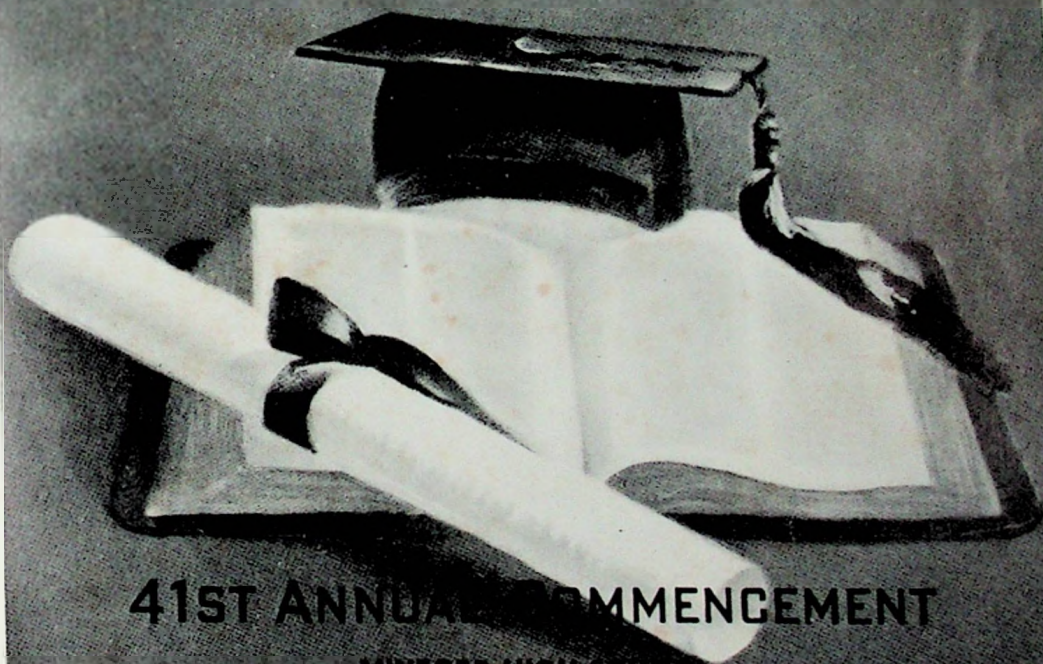

A high school means projects and clubs with their fun,

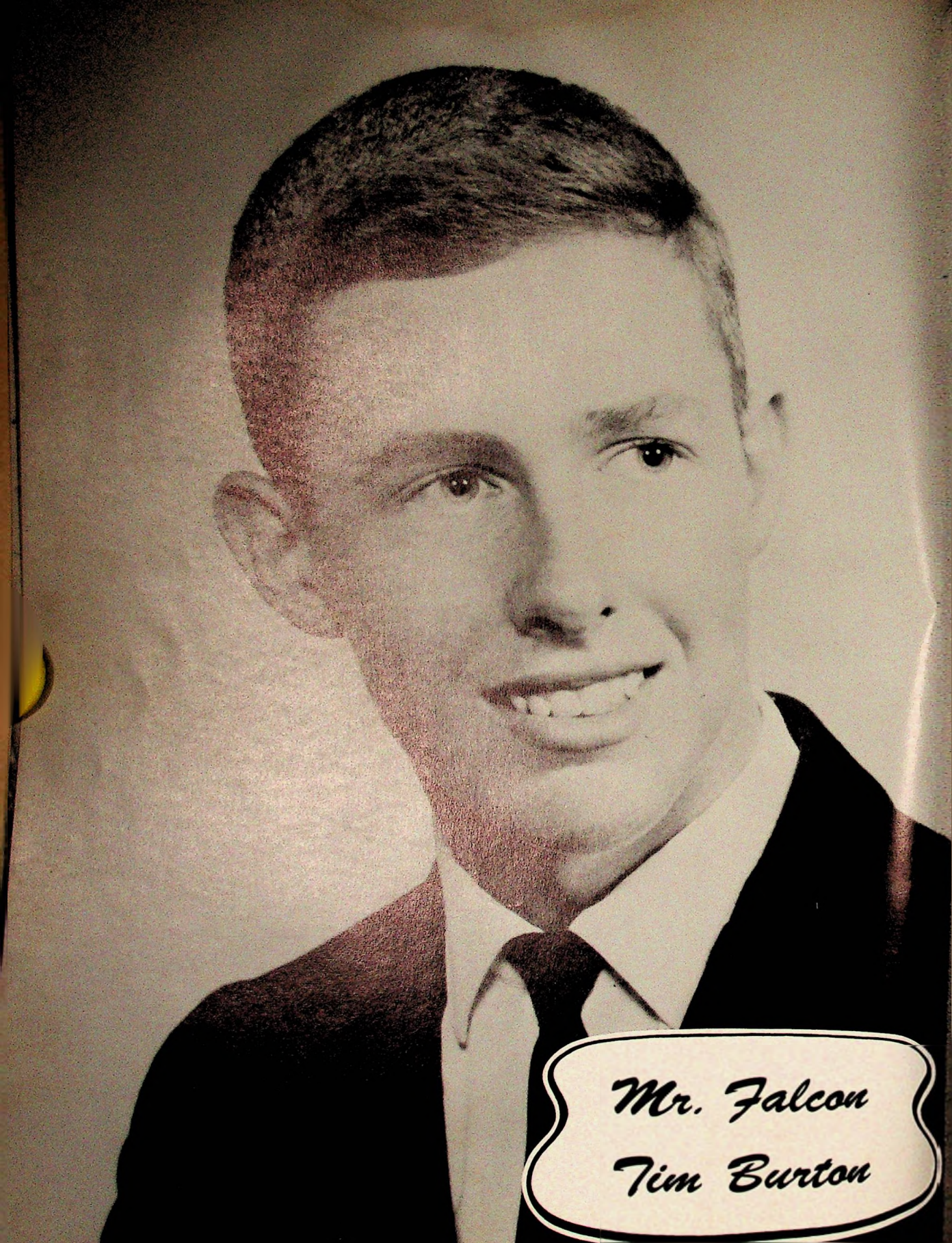
And everyone working till all tasks are done;
