

## Third Morthwest Student Wins DSC Scholarship

Valued at \$6,000, the scholarship provides a four-year college course leading to a Bachelor Degree in Industrial and Labor Relations.

Two other former Northwest students--Dennis Davis and Carolyn Diehlmann--won the DSC Scholarship in 1960 and 1962, respectively. They are now enrolled at Ohio State.

Established in 1956, the DSC Scholarship has been awarded to eight ambitious, deserving area students.

## Northwest Jakes S.O.C. and S.C.L. Titles



Northwest won 17 straight games and in the process captured its first Southern Ohio Conference championship and also wrapped up the Scioto County League championship.

The Mohawks ended the SOC season with a 8-0 record and the county league season with a 7-0 record.

Coach Stan Doddridge was named SOC Basketball Coach of the Year.




Berl G. Haney, our Executive Head, has devoted much time and effort to assure a better education for the students in the Northwest School District.
