The selection process has been a very long and tough procedure, but Keith was chosen in a group of five from the over 300 applicants.
Keith is well trained and prepared to accept his new assignment with the University. He began his preparation as a manager with the eighth grade athletic teams while an eighth grader himself at East. That very summer. some five years ago, he began to attend workshops and seminars in athletic training. He also began his studies for an E.M.T. (Emergency Medical Technician) rating and completed both the Red Cross Basic First Aid and Advanced

Courses.
In the 10th grade year, he again served all the same teams, and began his limited experiences as trainer to the girls programs in basketball and track. He returned again to the O.S.U. Buckeye Sports Camp for Athletic Trainers for continued study. As an 11th grade student. Keith had completed basic lifesaving courses at the Red Cross, the advanced course in swimming and was studying for the instructor's certificate in water safety. He again served all athletic teams at East High School and continued to be an honor roll student.
For the third consecutive year, he returned to Columbus to attent the O.S.U. Buckeye sports camp.
Then as a senior, his training duties at their highest level ever. Keith began the campaign necessary to achieve one of the coveted student trainer positions at Ohio State Many local coaches, business men. physicians, teachers and many others wrote the necessary letters to the Ohio State Athletic Department and Head Trainer Billy Hill in particular. to recommend Keith for the position. East High School is indeed proud of Keith Burke and his accomplishments and contributions to the East High Athletic Program. He has put in countless hours and accompanied many athletic teams to many comtests and his four years as the high school's Athletic Trainer.
Coach Jim Smith, with whom Keith has worked all his years in the program says about

Keith. "The young man is simply amazing. In spite of his handicap. he leis very little get in his way. He is a tireless worker, and does an excellent job. He gets up and down the hill to the practice field with difficulty, but is always there. He has a thorough knowledge of his subject and takes each case as it comes. I am very proud of him and his accomplishments. He has much of which to be proud. We wish him much luck in his new assignment.
Keith begins his new assignment this week when he reports to the University to begin studies for the summer quarter. He will begin his new duties in August.
