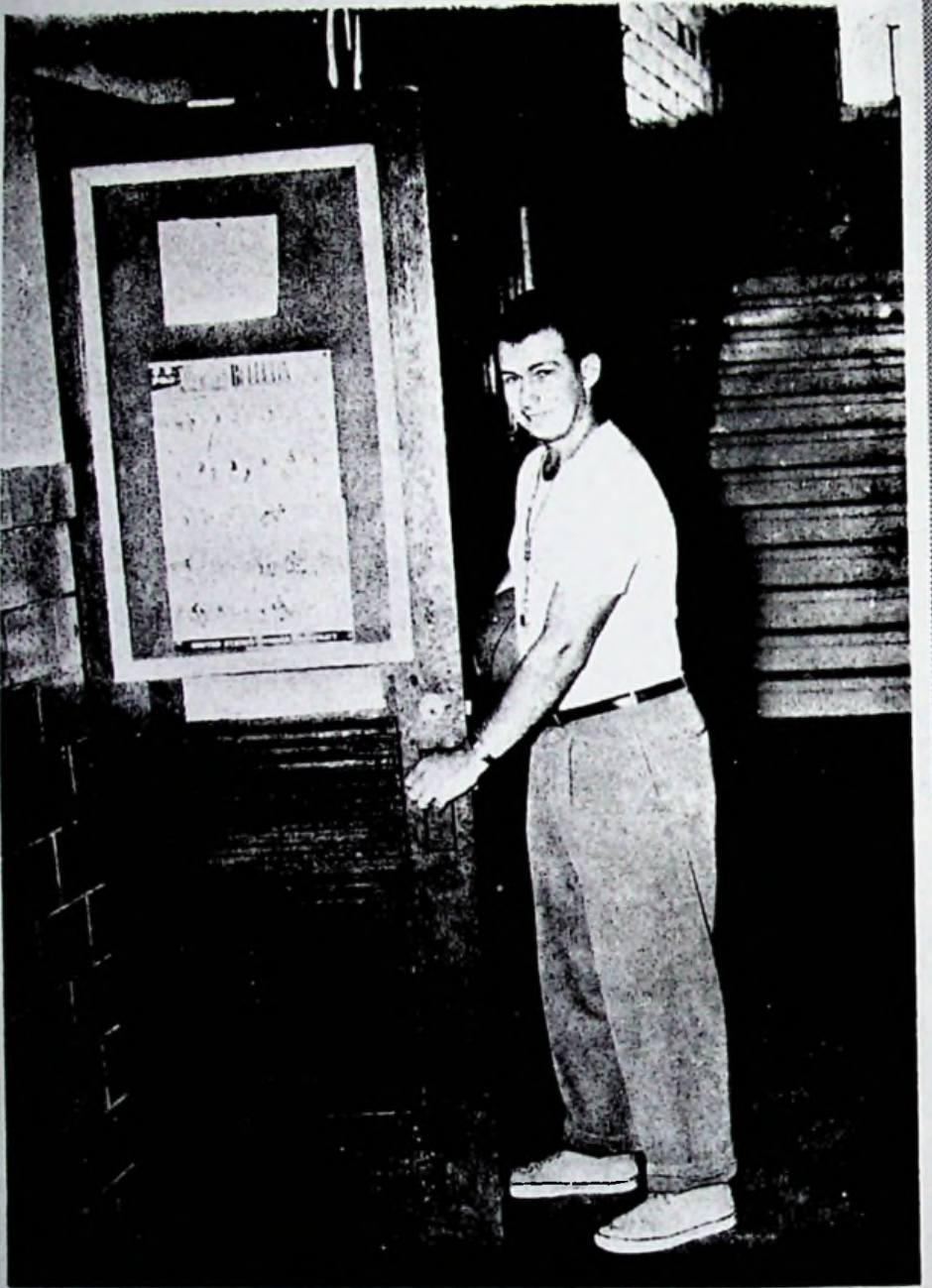

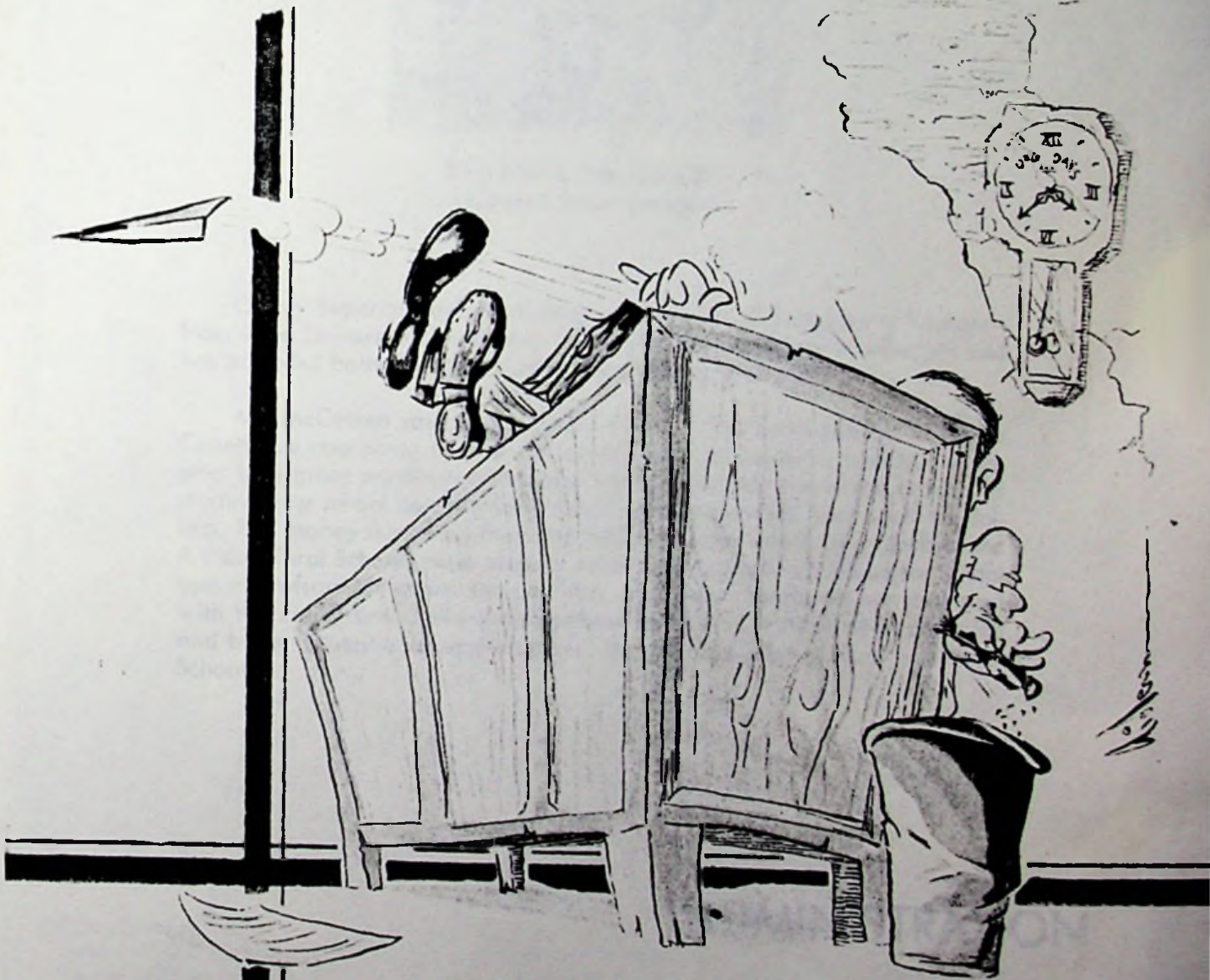

County Superintendent McCowen received his B. S. degree in Education from Ohio University, the Masters Degree from Northwestern University and has attended both Otterbein College and Harvard University.

Mr. McCowen said in a statement to us, "The Rural Schools of Scioto County are continuing to meet the great demands brought about by the impact of a great enrollment increase. Several Districts are in the process of starting new school construction amounting to somewhat over a million dollars. This money is coming from the Federal Government as a result of the A Plant. Rural Schools have already received thousands of dollars for school operation from the same source." Mr. McCowen continued his statement with this conclusion, "We shall continue to strive for the best in buildings and better educational opportunities for all boys and girls of our Rural Schools."
