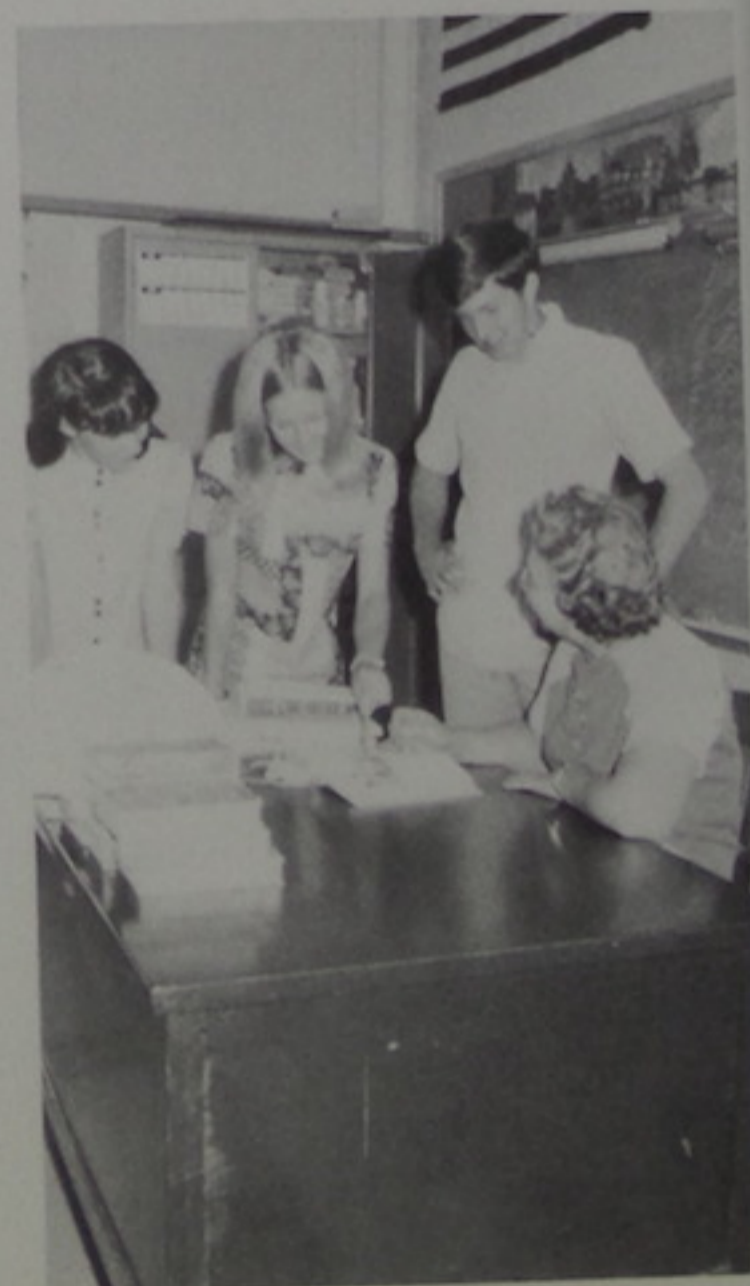

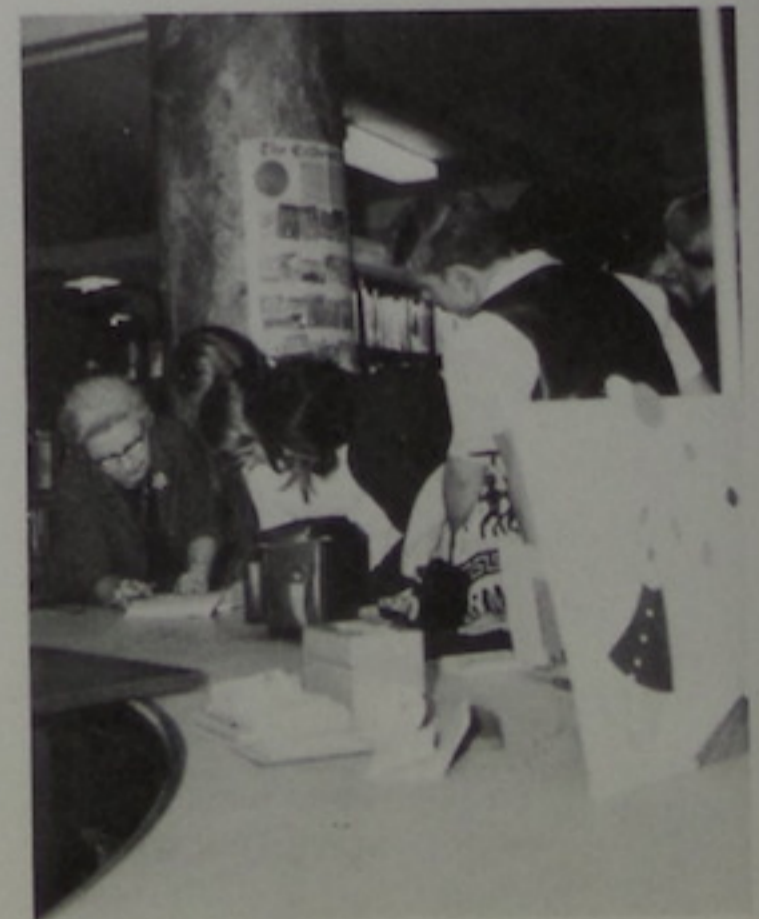


THE '71 YEARBOOK STAFF DOES
