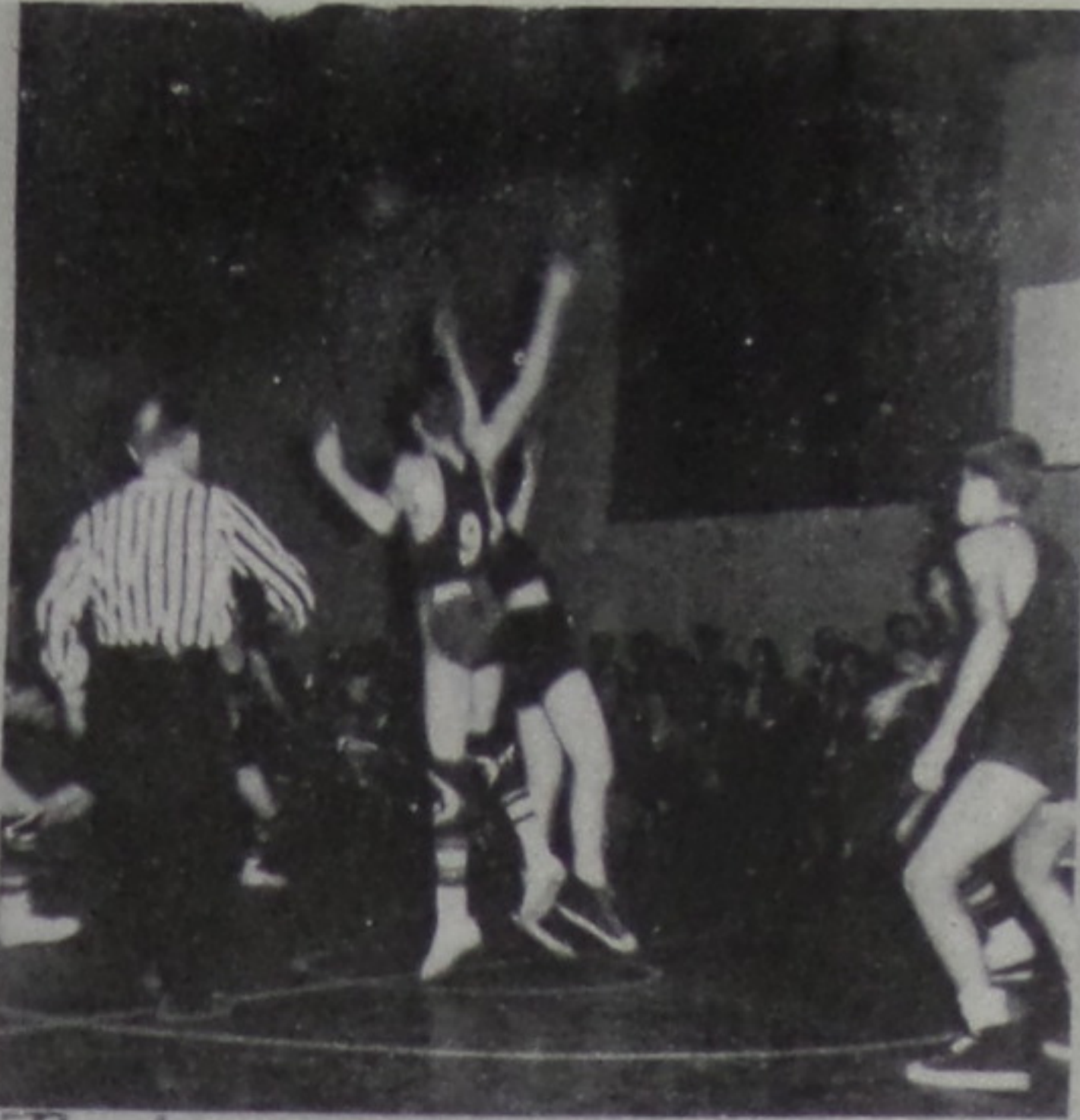
During all four years we have had representatives from our class on scholarship teams, baseball, and basketball teams, in the band and glee club, in fact, in all school activities.

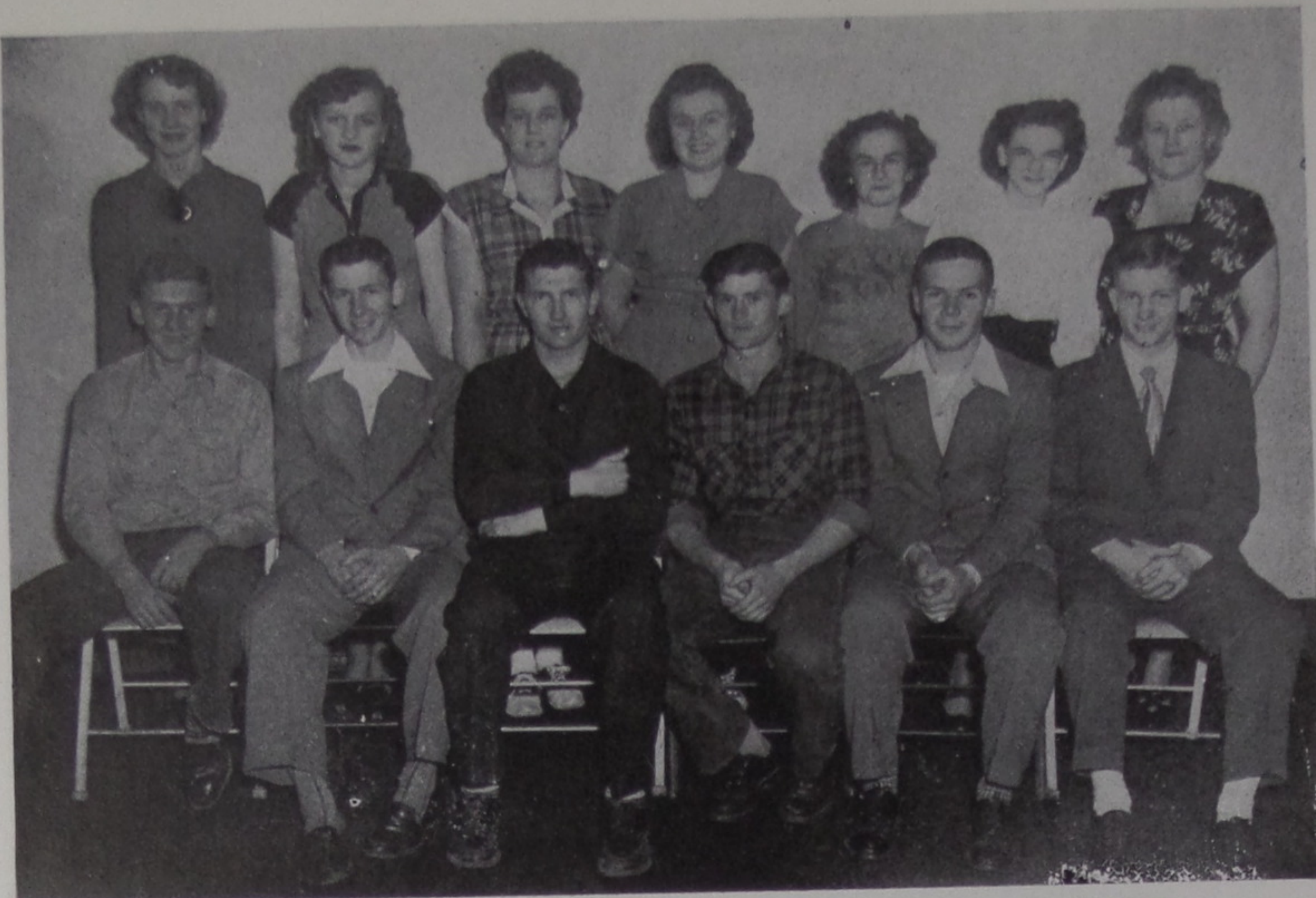

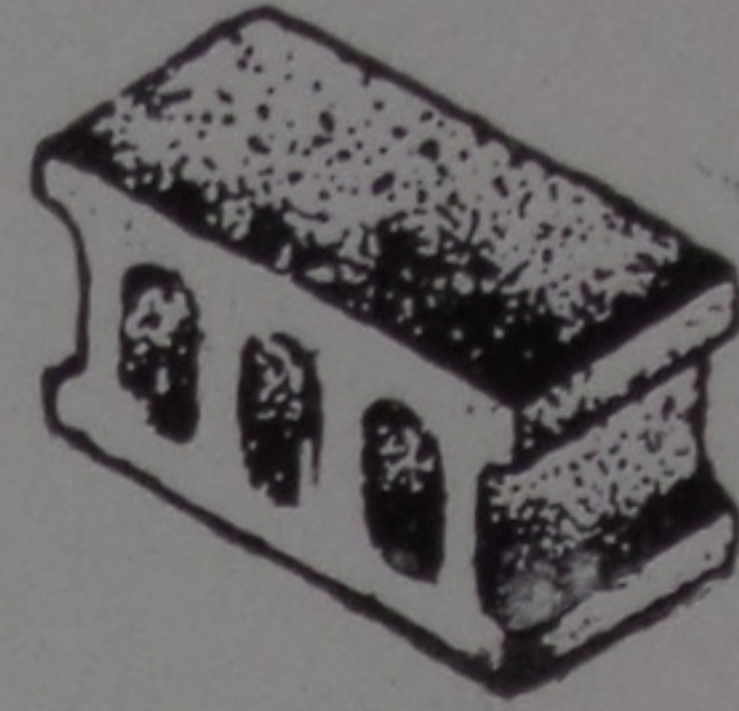

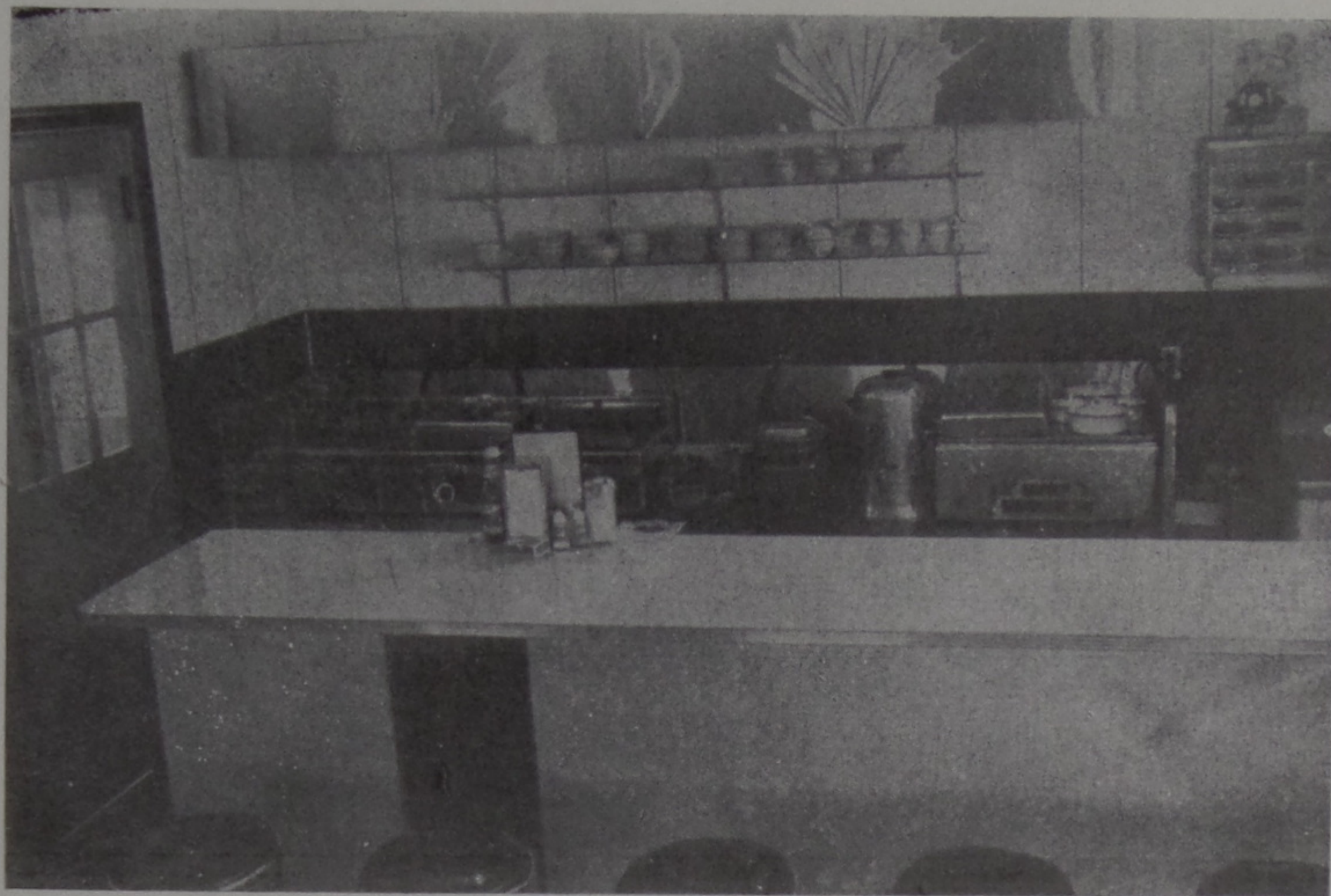
