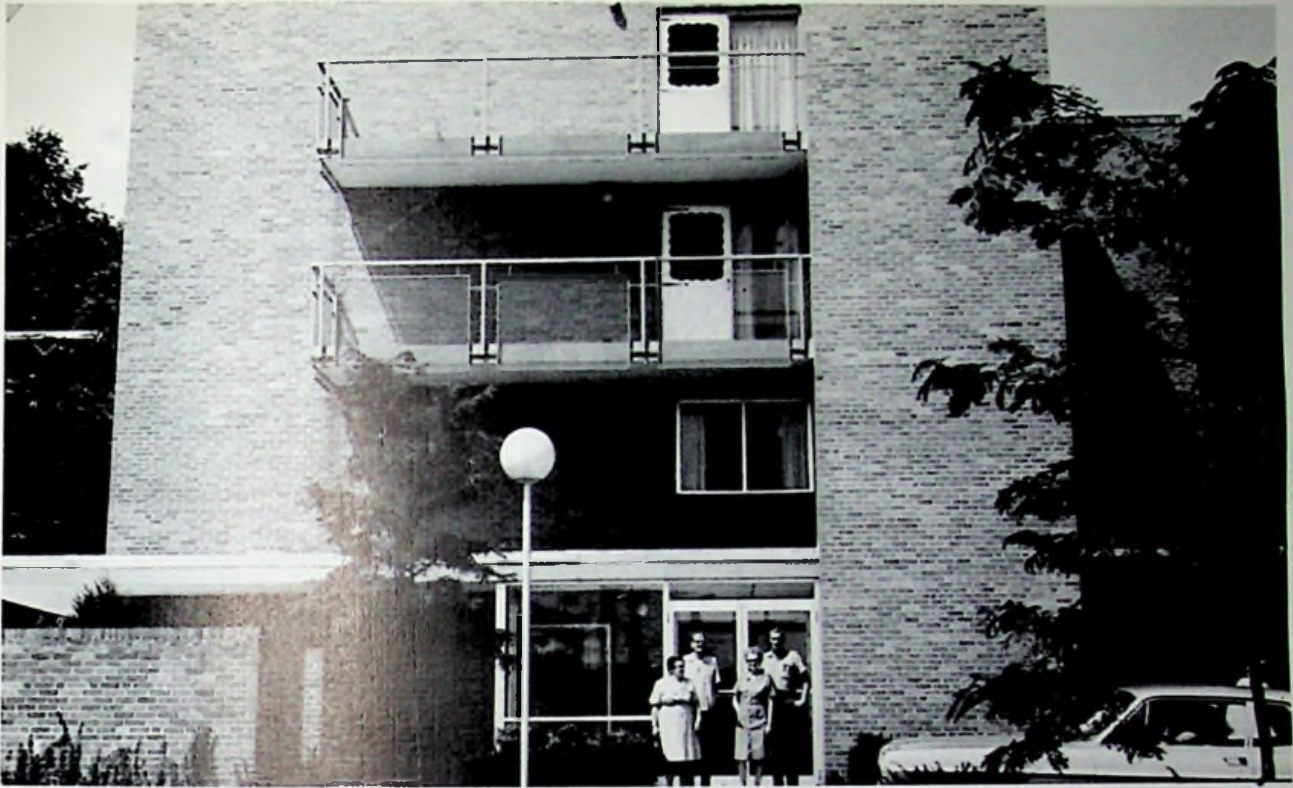

We were very proud this year as Ed Thompson was selected captain of the SOC All Stars and a member of the second team. All Ohio.

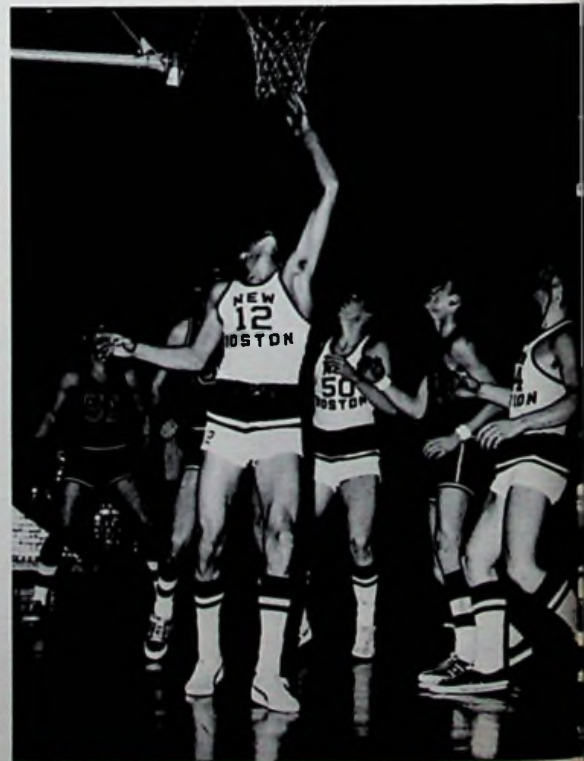
