all day.

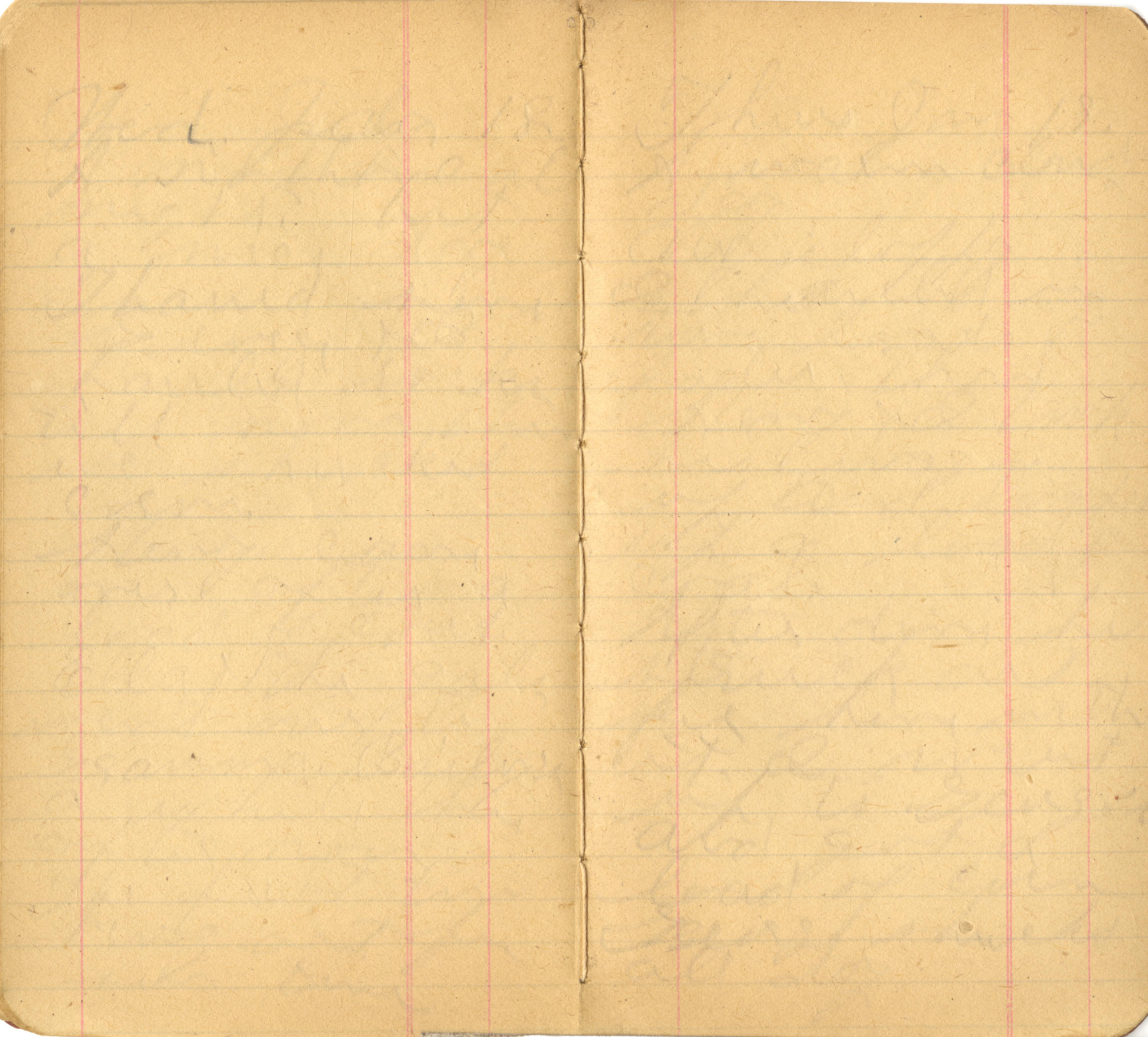
I visited at
