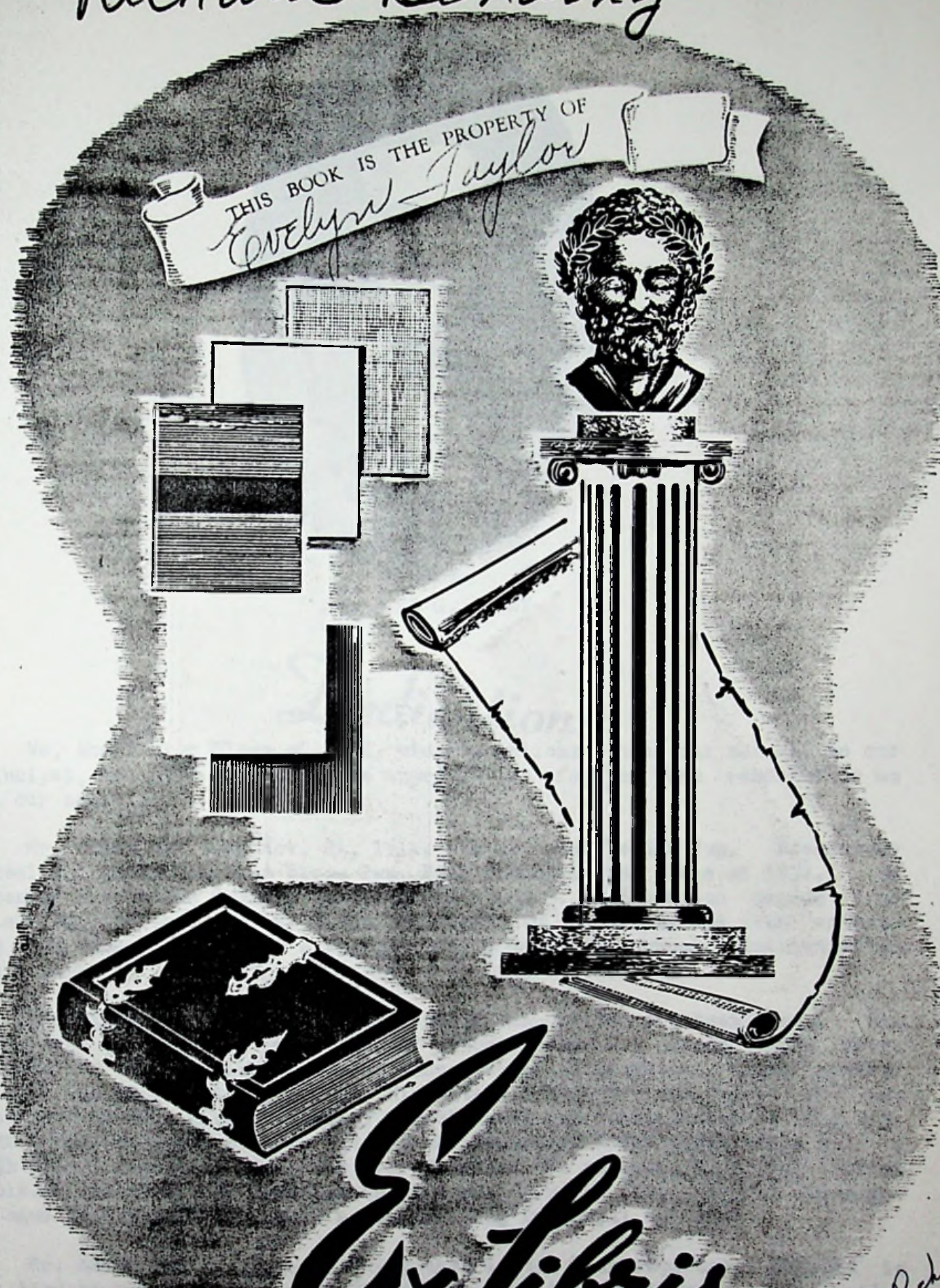

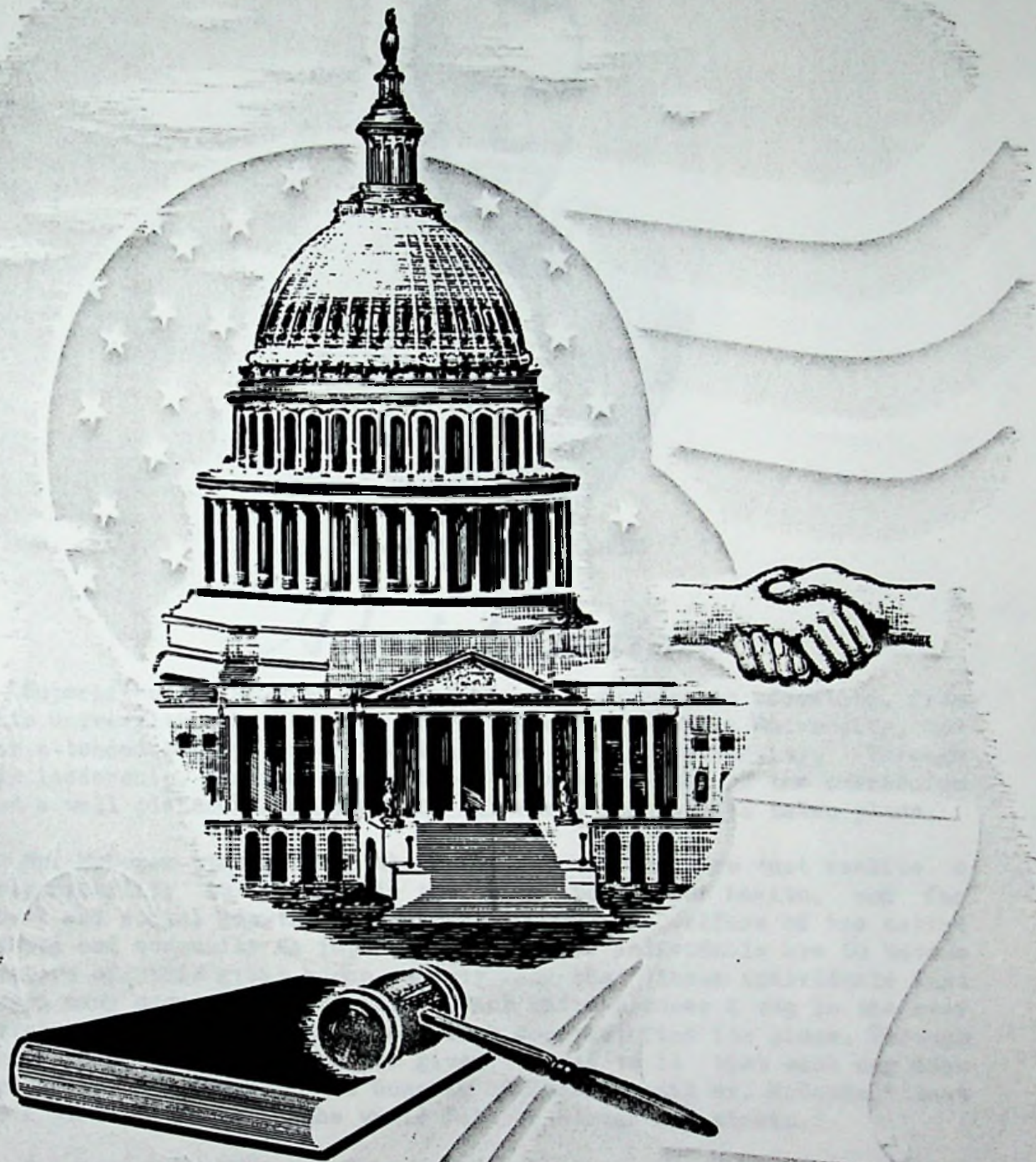
## *Dedication*

We, the Senior Class of 1952, wish to dedicate this, our annual, to our principal, Mr. Berl G. Haney, in appreciation for the work rendered to us and our school.

Mr. Haney was born Nov. 21, 1912. He attended Vernon Twp. Elementary School and graduated from Bloom Twp. High School in the class of 1931. He attended Rio Grande College and received his B.S. in Education degree from Wilmington College. He has attended Ohio State University and done extensive work toward his Master's Degree with a major in School Administration and a minor in Counseling and Guidance at Ohio University.

Mr. Haney has taught in Scioto County Schools for nineteen years. His experience has included many types of school work. His first three years of teaching was done in a one-room school where he taught all eight grades. He then was principal of the Lyra Elementary School for one year. He was principal of Eden Park Elementary School until the construction of Clay Twp. High School at which time he entered the Secondary Educational field as a High School teacher. After one year there he was assigned as a High School Athletic director. He remained in this position for five years at which time he came to Rush Twp. Schools as Supervising Principal and coach.

Mr. Haney has seen many developments in the Rush Twp. Local Schools in the time he has been with us. These developments have increased the educational opportunities to the girls and boys of our district. Mr. Haney's plans always include continued progressive improvement as situations and resources become available.
